Argentina emerged as a top-flight player on the world wine scene during the 1990s, its reputation soaring on the international excitement surrounding high-altitude Malbec from Mendoza. But Argentina has far more than just this signature expression to offer. The country's exciting array of distinct, approachable wines crafted from a vast range of grape varieties planted at altitudes ranging from 487 metres up to a staggering 1,700 metres offers wine lovers amazing choice and value at all price points.



# Malbec

Argentina's flagship red, Malbec shines in the cool temperatures and intense sunlight of the foothills of the Andes. The grape reflects exciting stylistic variations depending upon the altitude at which it's planted; the higher the vineyard, the more floral and elegant the wine. Blending grapes sourced from different altitudes produces wines of unique complexity and nuance. Mendoza's long growing season encourages ripe, fresh, vibrant Malbec, and the abundant sunlight and cool, dry desert conditions of Patagonia produce elegant, distinct expressions. Great on its own and ideal for week-night meals or milestone events, this deeply coloured, intensely flavoured, versatile wine makes a welcome addition to any table.

**VERSADO MALBEC 2017**

Luján de Cuyo, Mendoza  
(Ann Sperling and Peter Gamble)

Following a very wet 2016 El Niño vintage, 2017 in Mendoza turned into a much more typically dry growing season. This junior partner in the tiny Versado lineup, a project by Canadian winemaking couple Sperling and Gamble, is wild fermented in concrete vats and made using “very little” manipulation before aging in older French oak barrels. It has such an expressive nose of cassis, dark plums, some red berry and floral notes with subtle savoury spices. It’s plush and ripe on the palate with complex layers of dark fruits, licorice, loamy/earthy notes and length through a lifted finish. A lovely drop that can be aged for 5+ years. **VERSADO ANCIENT RESERVA  
MALBEC 2014**

Mendoza

(Ann Sperling and Peter Gamble)

Owner and winemaking consultant Peter Gamble and chief winemaker Roberto de la Mota have created a blockbuster Argentine red for the 2014 vintage. Made from the iconic Malbec grape, this wine underwent a spontaneous fermentation, rather than one induced by the winemaker with specific yeasts. The wine was aged in oak barrels. This is another gorgeous red wine from Versado – this wine and winemaker perform consistently well every year. Aromas of fleshy black fruit, dried herbs, spices and pepper. Pair with grilled lamb. Highly recommended. Drink: 2017-2024. Score: **95** (nataliemaclean.com, June 24, 2017)

# Bonarda

Bonarda is virtually unique to Argentina, where it's second only to Malbec in terms of plantings. It was originally prized for its usefulness in adding colour and fruitiness to blends, but site specificity and care in the vineyard have shown it capable of creating profound single-varietal wines, especially when made with fruit from older vines. Bonarda has a keen affinity for oak, and the wines offer complex red fruit and spice, with a deep, dark colour and excellent structure and body. Bonarda first appeared in Argentina in the 19th century and the country has many old-vine plantings, including some over 100 years old.

**EL ENEMIGO EL MIRADOR SINGLE VINEYARD BONARDA 2017**

Mendoza  
(Adrianna Catena, Alejandro Vigil, Piedemonte al Sur)

A Bonarda from an old vineyard planted in clay soils up to 12 feet deep in El Mirador, Rivadavia, aged for 12 months in old foudres. The nose is all raspberry and sour cherry plus hints of quince and herbs. Complex with a soft feel in the mouth, even though the tannins are a little sharp, bringing a pleasant roughness and lending a corrective vigor toward the end. A delicious take on wine from a warm climate. Drinking window: 2020-2030. Score: **93** (Joaquín Hidalgo, vinous.com, Oct. 2020)

Black currant, dark plum and berry aromas are lightly floral and hint at herbs, giving this Bonarda an elegant nose. A juicy, lifted palate is pulpy but finessed. Raspberry, cherry and currant flavors are a touch reedy, while this tastes slightly of red licorice candy accented by herbs on the finish. Drink through 2025. Editors' Choice. Score: **94** (Michael Schachner, *Wine Enthusiast*, Sept. 1, 2021)

# Cabernet Sauvignon

The same conditions that benefit Malbec in Mendoza produce distinct, powerful Cabernet Sauvignon. Poor, stony soils force vines to work harder and dig deeper to find nutrients, stressing the vines and resulting in wines with impressive flavour intensity. Ripeness, intense fruit flavours and well-defined minerality are hallmarks of Mendoza Cabernet Sauvignon, and the long growing season combined with the cool conditions found at altitudes create wines with high levels of natural acidity. The notable lift and freshness found in Mendoza's Cabernets, along with the structured tannins and robust flavours, make these wines perfect for a fine cut of beef.

It spends 14 months in a combo of French and American oak, bringing layers of toasty spice to a core of rich blackcurrant and berry fruit. Savour over the next five years with blackened beef tips.

# Cabernet Franc

Plantings of Cabernet Franc have nearly doubled in Argentina over the last 10 years. Impressive, yes, but this still means that of the nearly 220,000 hectares of vineyards in the country, roughly only 1,300 are planted to Cabernet Franc, making it a rare gem indeed. Long hang time and significant diurnal variation in the vineyards allow for wines with intense, ripe dark fruit, coffee, spice and savoury herbal tones. These are wines of depth and quality that overdeliver on value and are creating great excitement among producers and consumers alike. Watch this space; Cabernet Franc is poised to become Argentina's next big thing.

# Chardonnay

“Cool-climate” and “Chardonnay” go together like “yes” and “please.” Grown around the world, Chardonnay can vary dramatically in style from steely, light-bodied, high-acid wines with pear and apple notes in cooler climates to full-bodied, creamy wines with exotic tropical notes such as mango and banana in warmer regions. The high-altitude vineyards of Mendoza equate to wines with laser-sharp acidity and acutely defined ripe peach, pear and citrus notes. Argentine Chardonnay is also widely used (with Pinot Noir) to make some of the New World’s finest, most approachably priced classically styled sparkling wines.

# Pinot Noir

As in their ancestral home of Burgundy, where Chardonnay flourishes so too does Pinot Noir. The same cool-climate sites and conditions that yield exceptional Chardonnay allow for the crafting of classically styled Pinot. In Patagonia, which is Argentina's southernmost wine region, Pinot Noir is king. Though considered an emerging region, Patagonia has a long history of winemaking. The area has many pre-phylloxera plantings of Pinot and produces wines from some of the world's oldest Pinot vines. Argentine Pinot is lithe and fresh, with classic red berry and earthy flavours. Paired with Chardonnay, it's also an important player in traditional-method sparkling wines.

# Sparklers

First made here in the 19th century, Argentine sparkling wine began to gain true momentum in 1959, when Moët & Chandon chose Mendoza for its first overseas operation. High levels of acidity are essential for crafting traditional-method sparkling wine, and the extreme conditions in Mendoza provide this with certainty. Taking advantage of their unique vineyards, winemakers can produce traditional-method sparkling wines in a wide range of styles, from light, youthful and fruity to mature, intense and thought-provoking. Stylistically, Argentine traditional-method sparklers are a delicious middle ground between Italy's Prosecco and France's Champagne.

The best Icewines in the world are made right here in Ontario. Our intrepid vintners harvest fruit frozen on the vine in the depths of winter and use it to craft something uniquely enchanting. Here, four local winemakers give us the cold hard facts.

## **Amélie Boury** **Château des Charmes**

“Growing up in France, I had never tasted Icewine until I came to Ontario. The only sweet wine I had in France was Vendanges Tardives made in Alsace from Riesling and Gewurztraminer. My first Icewine vintage as winemaker was in 2012. Not many people know this, but not every year is an Icewine vintage, even in Canada. And even in good Icewine vintages, making it is challenging. We pick the fruit by hand, which isn’t easy in the cold and snow. But once at the winery, the whole press room gets scented with apricot and honey fragrance, and it’s wonderful.”

## **JL Groux** **Stratus Vineyards**

“When I was making wine in Bordeaux, I had zero experience of Icewine. I didn’t even know it existed, to be honest. My first Icewine vintage was in 1988 and my first as head winemaker was in 1991; both were Vidal. My first Riesling Icewine was several years later. Riesling is less hardy than Vidal, so it’s more hands-on and more expensive to make, but it’s worth it. The big treasure of Riesling Icewine is acidity. It’s easier to make an elegant, balanced Icewine from Riesling than any other variety. Riesling is also known for showing terroir. When it comes to Icewine, the biggest aspect of terroir is that you can make Icewine here in the first place. The soil isn’t as fundamental, but the climate is everything. Of course, part of terroir is the people, and wine-makers in Ontario are second to none with Icewine.”

## **Levi de Loryn** **Jackson-Triggs Estate Winery**

“I grew up in Australia, and the first time I tasted Icewine was at Adelaide University. I found it very rich and elegant. When I arrived in Canada, I was reacquainted with Icewine, and the ones that really stood out to me were those that showed a balance between sweetness and acidity. What I love about Vidal Icewine is that what you get on the nose you also get on the palate: incredible richness, elegant fruit and decadent complexity, all in balance with that powerful Niagara acidity.”





**Scott McGregor**  
**Lakeview Cellars**

"I've been involved in making Icewine since 1996, and I believe my first vintage as winemaker was 2004. If I remember correctly, it was a Cabernet Franc Icewine and it ended up winning a silver medal at the Canadian Wine Awards. Cabernet Franc is great for Icewine because it ripens well here in the Niagara region and we have had success keeping the fruit in good condition during the extra time on the vine until harvest. Most vintages of Cabernet Franc Icewine yield good depth of colour and a flavour profile that's uniquely Icewine, with a nice berry character."

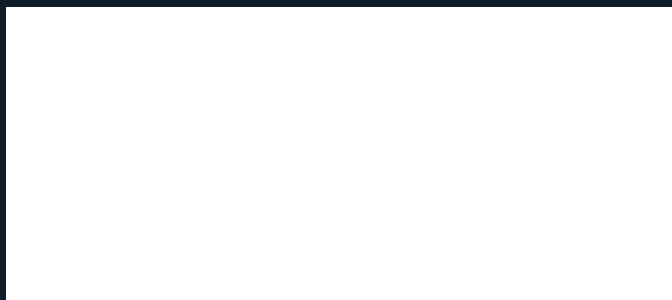
