# BORDEAUX

Most wine lovers recognize Bordeaux for its stately châteaux (hey, it's the epicentre of the wine world for a reason), but it also boasts scenic rivers, historic bridges, towering cathedrals, formal French gardens and more. **Place de la Bourse**, situated along the Garonne River, is a stunning example of 18th-century French architecture. Crossing the Garonne itself stands the **Pont de Pierre**: an intricate brickwork bridge built under the auspices of Napoleon. Surrounding the châteaux are vineyards of Cabernet Sauvignon (mainly in the gravelly soils of the Left Bank), Merlot (mainly the clay-rich Right Bank), Cabernet Franc and a handful of others.

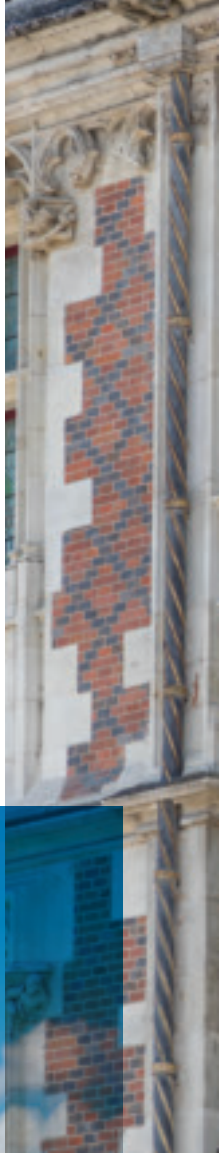

# LOIRE VALLEY

Colloquially known as “the garden of France,” this breathtaking valley traces the path of the country’s longest river: the Loire. Set amongst the region’s natural beauty are French Renaissance castles including **Château de Chambord**, commissioned by King Francis I in the early 16th century; and royal cottages, one of which, **Château du Clos Lucé**, was home to Leonardo da Vinci in his twilight years. As the Loire meanders through the countryside, the wines reflect the local landscape. Where the river meets the Atlantic, the signature wine is Muscadet, and further inland are pockets of Cabernet Franc, Pinot Noir, Chenin Blanc and Sauvignon Blanc, the latter finding its finest expressions in the villages of Pouilly-Fumé and Sancerre.

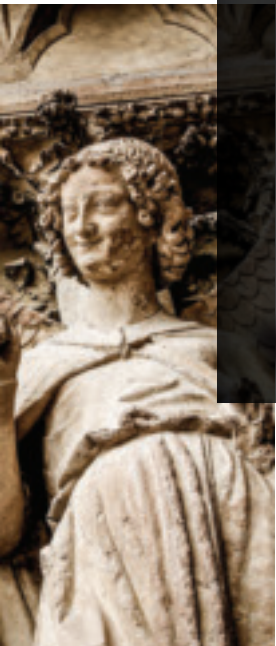
# CHAMPAGNE

In the north of France is where you'll find **Reims Cathedral**. This 13th-century Gothic marvel is the site of kingly coronations long ago. Equally impressive is the **Château de Sedan**: a seven-storey medieval castle and fortress that once housed artillery and royals alike and is now a luxury hotel and museum. The region is also, of course, home to the crown jewel of sparkling wines. Uniquely chalky limestone soils provide the perfect environment for growing the brilliantly crisp Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier and Pinot Noir used to make the world's finest bubbles.

# ALSACE

Nestled between the Vosges and Black Forest mountain ranges in the northeast of France is Alsace, with its mixture of French, Germanic and Swiss influences. The region's quaint Bavarian villages are framed by rivers and canals, while medieval castles and Gothic cathedrals rise above clay-tile rooftops. At the centre of Strasbourg's Grande Île is **Petite France**, the old quarter of the city. Along with nearby **Strasbourg Cathedral**, it's renowned for its Rayonnant Gothic architecture. Alsace is a foodie's dreamland, boasting more Michelin-starred restaurants per capita than anywhere else in the world. No less enticing are the wines, which are labelled by grape variety and made predominantly from Riesling, Pinot Gris, Pinot Blanc and Gewurztraminer.

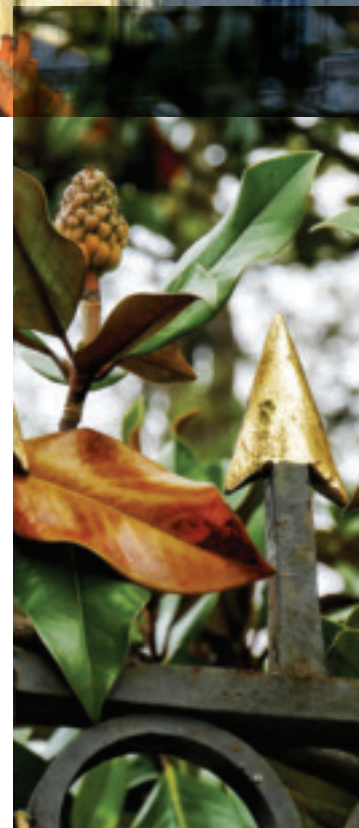

# BURGUNDY & BEAUJOLAIS

Defined by rolling hillsides, vineyards and farmland, this east-central French region is dotted with small towns and Romanesque abbeys. The capital, Dijon, is known for its traditional mustard, autumn gastronomic fair, and **Musée des Beaux-Arts** de Dijon: an art museum set in an ancient palace. In the heart of wine country is the walled city of Beaune, whose cobbled streets, tile-mosaic rooftops and historic **Hospices de Beaune** (a 15th-century hospital that now houses a museum and annual wine auctions) are hallowed images for wine travellers. The wines themselves, of course, are just as revered. In Burgundy proper, the terroir is expressed via Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, while in Beaujolais the medium of choice is Gamay.







### CHÂTEAU DE SANTENAY VIEILLES VIGNES MERCUREY 2018

A heady hint of oak appears first on the nose of this wine but is soon joined by ripe, tart red cherry. That cherry fruit is intense on the palate and comes with concentration and pervasive freshness, all the more remarkable in the warm 2018 vintage. The intense fruit is met by fine tannins and a lovely texture. Score: **92** (Anne Krebiehl, MW, *Wine Enthusiast*, Dec. 1, 2020)

# RHÔNE VALLEY

In between Burgundy and Provence, this hilly valley traces the mighty Rhône River as it flows south toward the Mediterranean. Lyon, the region's capital, sits at the junction of the Rhône and Saône, where medieval and Renaissance architecture provide the backdrop for an ancient Roman amphitheatre and, since 2014, the **Musée des Confluences**: a modern science centre and anthropology museum. Lyon also hosts one of Europe's most spectacular light festivals: the 150-year-old **Fête des Lumières**. In the vineyards, the north of the region is devoted to Syrah, while the south grows the Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and more that comprise the exalted wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape and its neighbours.

# THE SOUTH OF FRANCE

Famous for its sandy beaches and cozy seaside cafés basking in the Mediterranean sunshine, this vast area spans historic Languedoc-Roussillon and Provence and includes a diversity of terroirs, from the Pyrenees in the west to the Alps in the east. Among the region's cultural hotspots is the port city of Marseille, founded by the Greeks in 600 BCE and today a modern cultural hub featuring some 24 museums and 42 theatres. Standing watch over the city is the **Basilique Notre-Dame-de-la-Garde**: a 19th-century basilica in the Romanesque and Neo-Byzantine styles. To the east along the Mediterranean coast is the sumptuous French Riviera, which includes such stops as Cannes with its film festival and exclusive beach clubs; Saint-Tropez with its jet-set nightlife and yacht-filled harbours; and Nice with its Matisse museum and bustling **Promenade des Anglais** waterfront. Wines of the South of France are as diverse as the region itself, with Grenache and Mourvèdre among the signature grape varieties and rosé the most internationally recognized style.
