Sea Sun 2019 Pinot Noir is produced by Charlie Wagner from wine grapes sourced from California's cool-climate coastal vineyards. The Wagners come from a long line of Napa Valley wine grape growers and winemakers dating back to the 1850s. They're also the family who produce the coveted Caymus wines. Look for ripe cherry, plum, red berry compote, vanilla, flinty and toasty oak spice flavours vibrant on the palate. Tannins are fine-grained, giving a silky mouth-feel. Drink or hold. Drink: 2021-2025. Score: **90** (nataliemaclean.com, Dec. 18, 2021)

Murrieta's Reserva bottling is always up there with the best examples in the region, expressing vintage variation as well as terroir. The bodega reduced its crop in the vineyard to produce a wine with more concentration, marrying Tempranillo with 13% Graciano, Mazuelo and Garnacha and ageing it in 10% American wood. STATE OF GRACE

Led by Cabernet Sauvignon and Chardonnay, California is a hub of elegant, refined wines loved the world over.

It's been almost half a century since the Golden State proved their wines could stand with the best in the world at the now-famous Paris tasting of 1976. In that time, Californian winemaking has gone from strength to superstrength, with innovative techniques, increasingly specialized vineyard sites and truly passionate people making the difference. Featured here is a cadre of wines, from everyday affordable offerings to premium connoisseur favourites, to showcase what Cali does best.

The 1973 Stag's Leap Cabernet Sauvignon was the highest-rated red at the Paris Wine Tasting of 1976.

'S LEAP WINE

HISTORY REPEATS

.....

The Spanish planted wine grapes in California as far back as 1829 and the gold rush of the mid-19th century sparked an early winemaking boom, but the modern Californian wine industry began in earnest with a French-trained Russian by the name of **André Tchelistcheff**. Coming to California in the 1930s, Tchelistcheff established a wine laboratory in St. Helena and ushered in the era of premium Californian wine, becoming consulting oenologist and mentor to such luminaries as **Robert Mondavi**, **Warren Winiarski** and **Mike Grgich**. Mondavi, in turn, inspired a new movement of quality-focused family wineries, while Winiarski and Grgich crafted the red and white wines, respectively, that shocked the world by taking top spots in competition with French wines at the 1976 **Judgment of Paris** tasting.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

An eminent expat

.....

For generations, it was presumed that Cabernet Sauvignon would thrive nowhere besides its home vineyards of Bordeaux. California has shown that not only can Cabernet make great wines in the Golden State, it can actually make a whole new style of wine: big, bold, and brimming with ripe cassis character. The most famous examples come from **Napa** and **Sonoma**, where mountaintop vineyards grow wines with powerful tannic structure while sites lower down in the valley create smooth, round wines.

CLINE
CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2018

Vegan, Contra Costa County,
Sonoma County

Fruit from six vineyards (70% from Sonoma County and 30% from Contra Costa County) compose this American oak-aged red. Luscious aromas of licorice, leather, plum, and cinnamon toast entice the nose before black coffee and blackberry are coated in satin on a palate defined by supple yet structured tannins. Bittersweet dark chocolate carries more dark fruit to a balanced, long, and somewhat spicy finish. This entry-level Cabernet Sauvignon is the only Cabernet in the Daou portfolio made entirely of purchased fruit and is intended to be drunk young. The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon is made up of 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 13% Merlot, 8% Petit Verdot and 1% Cabernet Franc aged 11 months in 60% new French oak. Deep ruby-purple, it opens with pure crème de cassis and meaty touches, slow to unfurl, over pure blackberries, cedar and dried thyme. Medium to full-bodied, it explodes with flavor in the mouth, purely defined but very ripe, with a very finely grained frame and a youthful cloaking of new oak, finishing long, fresh and classy. CHARDONNAY

From crisp to creamy

.....

The most popular white wine grape on the planet, Chardonnay is grown in all sorts of climates, from quite cool to sunny and warm and everything in between. This is particularly true in California, where cool coastal sites tend to grow crisp, tangy, citrus-infused versions, while warmer sites make for rich, robust examples reminiscent of ripe tropical fruit. The winemaker can also put their own spin on the wine, using techniques like malolactic conversion to add buttery richness, or oak barrels to add toasty, smoky character.

REVERED REDS

Beyond Cab

.....

California's most renowned red wine varietal is undoubtedly Cabernet Sauvignon, but the Golden State has a lot more to boast in red. **Merlot** is grown in many of the same appellations as Cabernet, along with some vineyards closer to the coast, and typically shows bold flavours of ripe berry, cherry and chocolate. **Petite Sirah** is found in warmer pockets across the state and makes deep, concentrated wines packed with rich, dark fruit. **Pinot Noir** does best in cooler sites along the coast or at higher altitudes, making expressive wines tingling with tangy red berry and cherry. **Zinfandel** is grown in warmer vineyards and tends toward rich, jammy berry character and earthy spice.



RAVENSWOOD OLD VINE ZINFANDEL 2018

Lodi

Initially quite shy on the nose, blueberry and blackberry aromas start to emerge, encased in a velvety, smoky veneer. Flowing with cinnamon-dusted plums, violets, toast and sweet, vanilla-laced fruit, this is a powerful wine, large and imposing. Mouthfilling and viscous, but still managing to stay dry and long, the finish is speckled with dried blackberries, bitter nut skin and a bloody tang. It's no wonder that in a place endowed with such natural beauty as California, wineries are keen to do what's best for the land and the community. Indeed, there are few places that have a stronger sustainability movement anywhere on the globe. Local efforts have galvanized around a few leading organizations that certify sustainable vineyards, wineries and wines. A couple of logos to watch for are **Certified California Sustainable**, introduced in 2010 and now the most comprehensive sustainability program in the state; **Lodi Rules for Sustainable Winegrowing**, born in the Lodi appellation and featuring over 100 sustainability standards; and **SIP Certified**, whose pilot program dates back to 2008 in Monterey and Santa Barbara counties. All of these programs promote social responsibility (things like competitive wages, health, education, and community supports) along with sustainable vineyard management, water management, and energy efficiency.

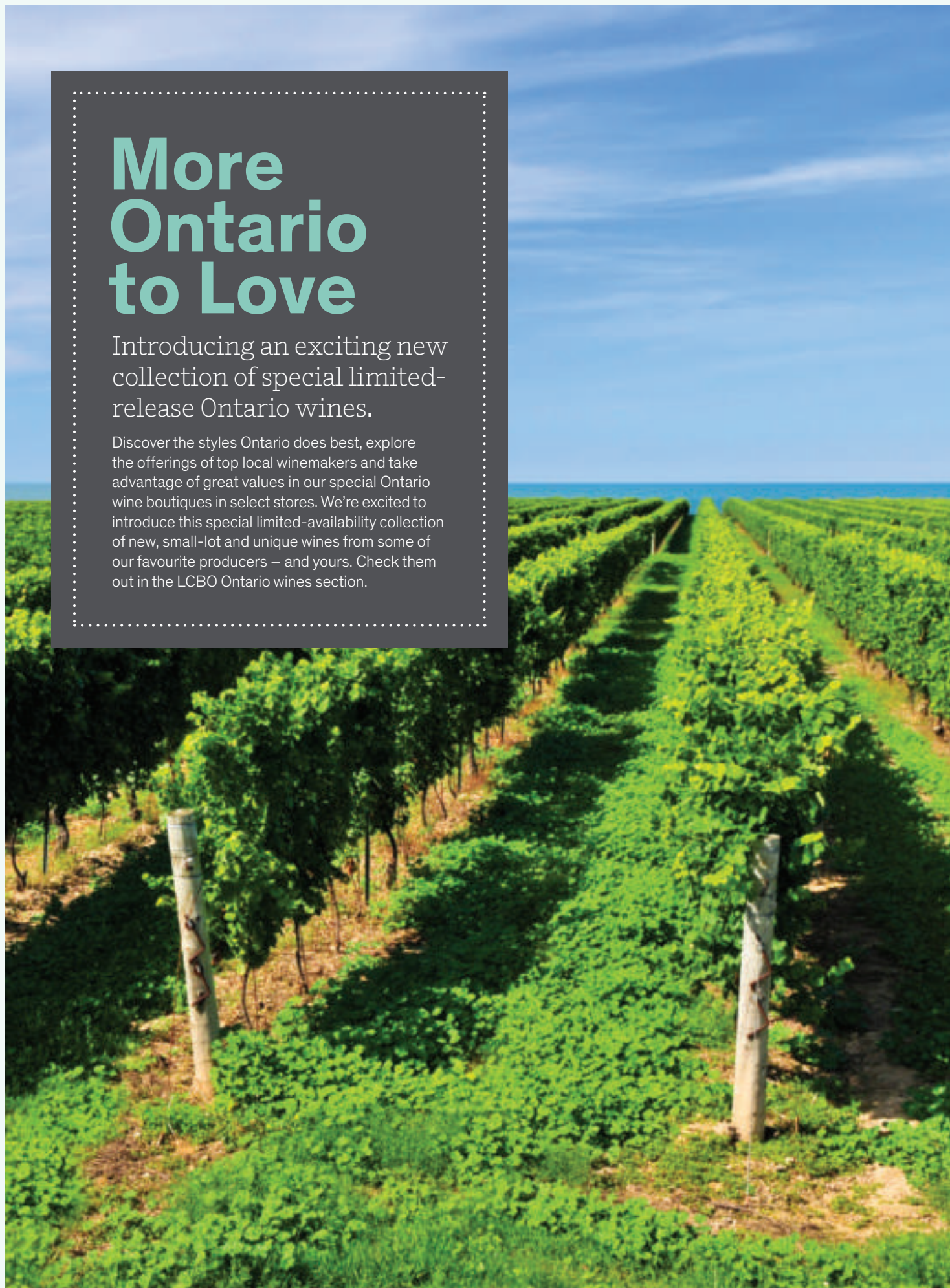

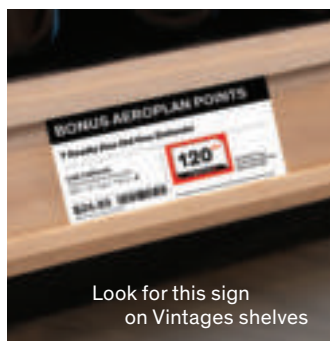

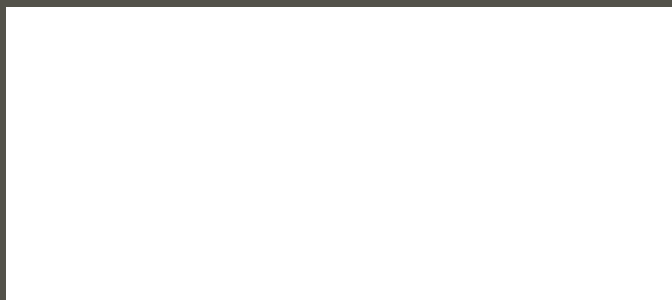
