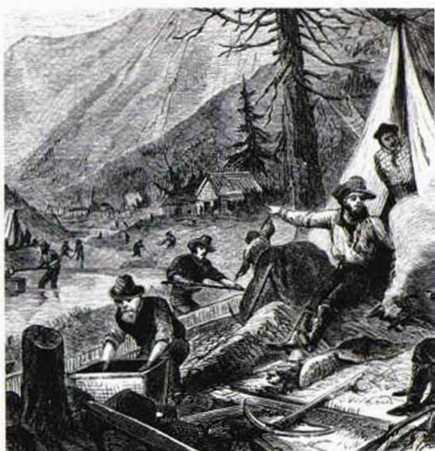




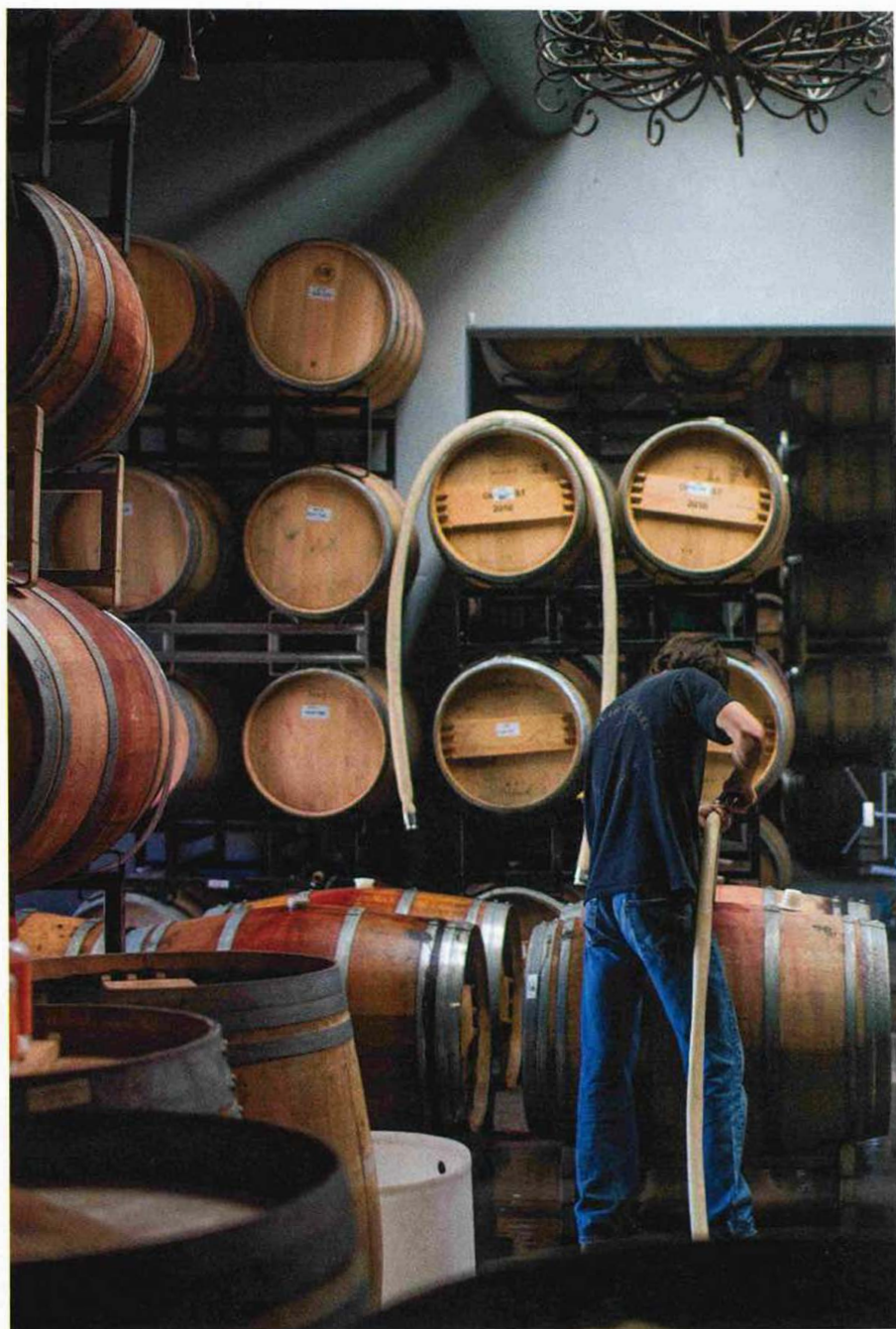
# CALIFORNIA

*Sunshine and cool breezes make for impressive Cabernet and Chardonnay*

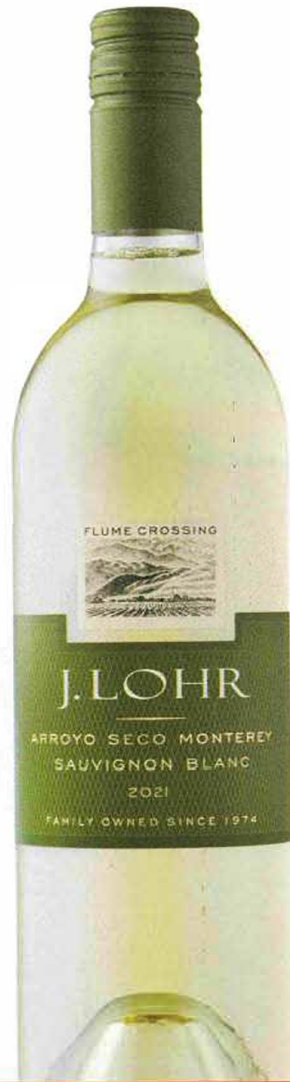
Though the most popular and famous US winemaking region, California was not where American winemaking began. That honour falls to (brace yourself) Florida, in the early 1560s. Californian wine was first made 200 years later, when Spanish Franciscan missionaries planted vines to produce communion wine.



The California gold rush of 1848-1855 saw a massive expansion of vineyard area and grape varieties planted, as the influx of fortune seekers included enterprising winemakers who found their own gold mines in the soils and abundant sunshine of California. To gain some idea of the scale of the California gold rush, consider this: the population of San Francisco exploded from roughly 1,000 people to more than 25,000 in 1848 alone.

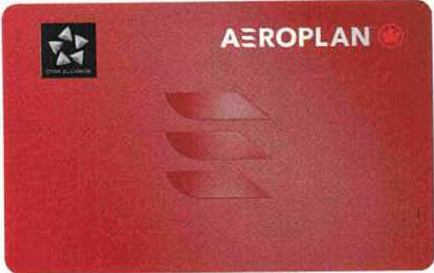
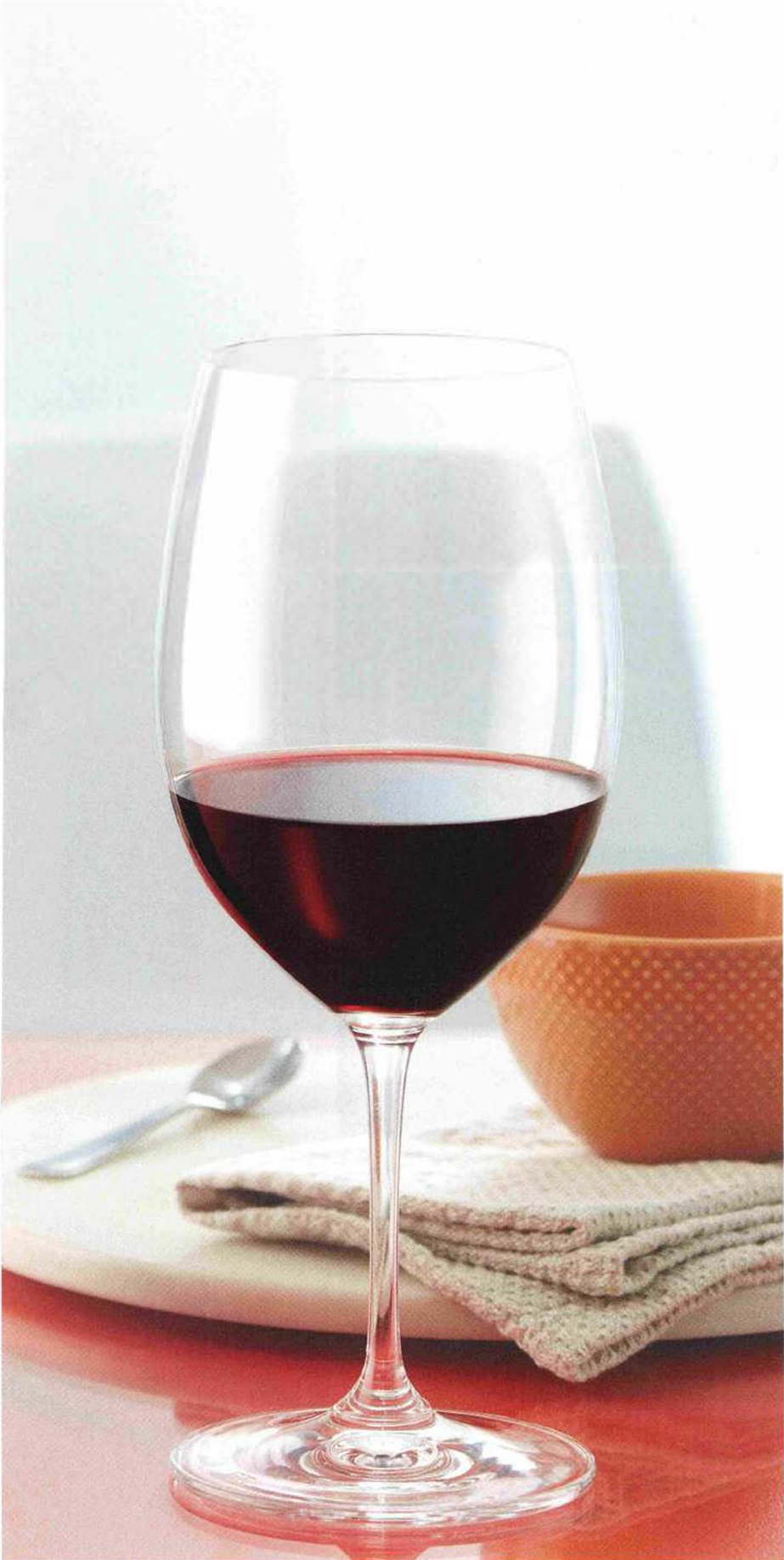

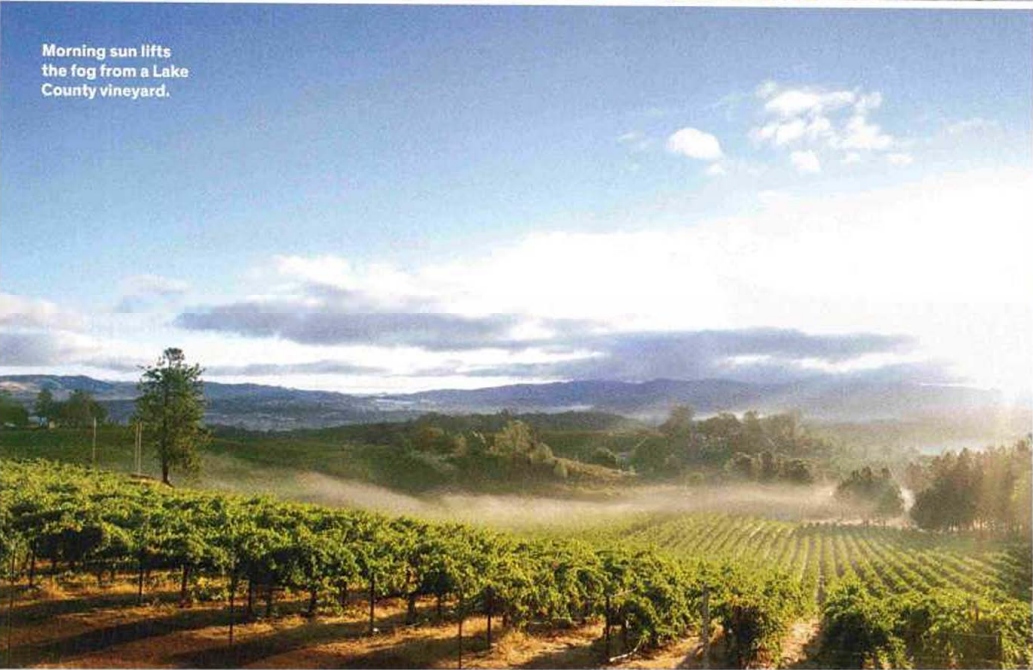

All of California's vineyards enjoy plentiful sunshine and most prime vineyards are situated where cooling Pacific Ocean breezes and fogs help the grapes ripen slowly, encouraging balanced wines. California's diverse soils and wide range of mesoclimates allow for the production of more than 100 different types of grapes, including **Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah** and **Zinfandel**. The pioneering spirit has never left California's winemakers, and in the 1960s, the arrival of entrepreneurial producers including Robert Mondavi, Julio Gallo, Joe Heitz and Louis Martini ushered in a new golden age that continues to this day.

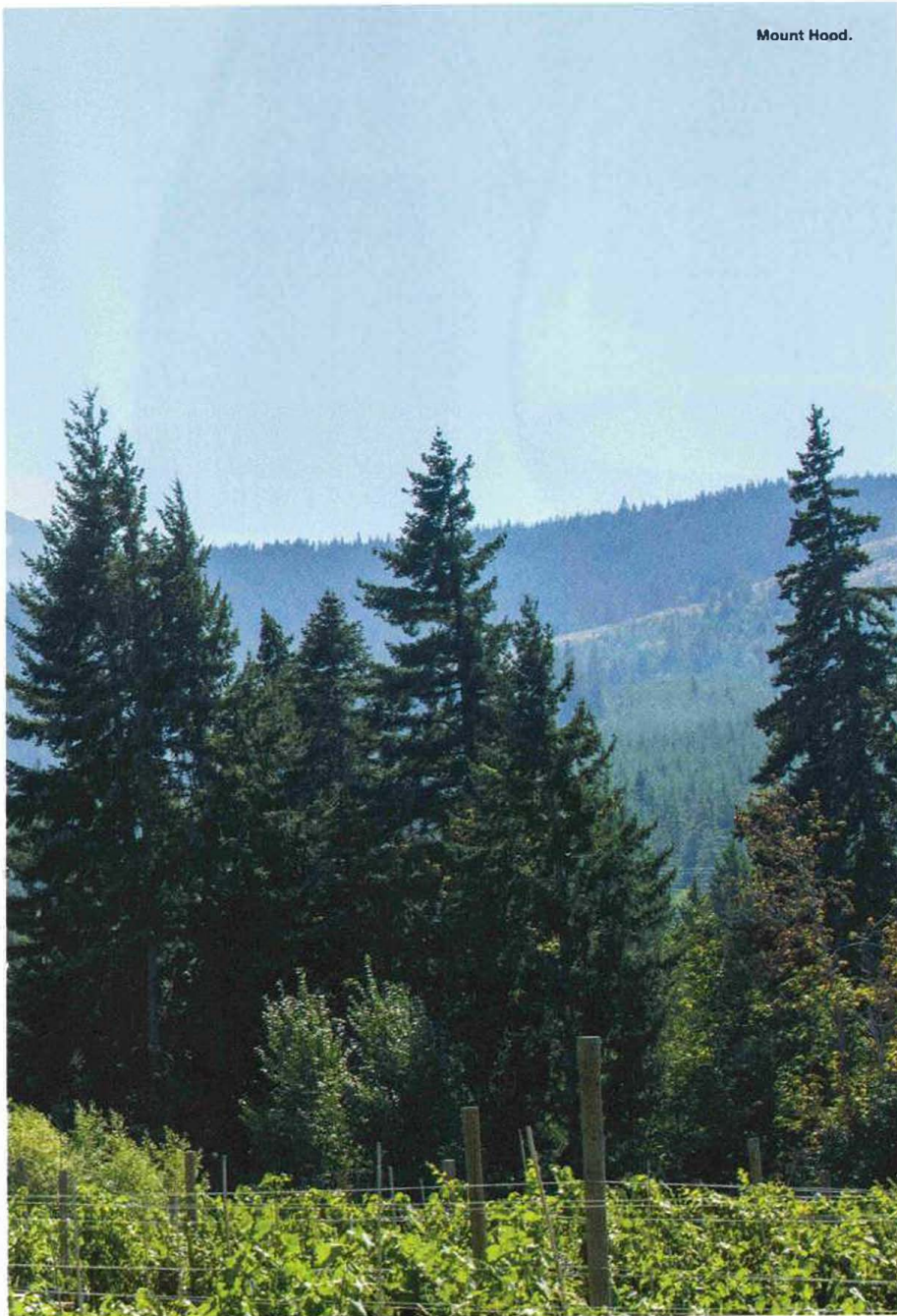


# OREGON

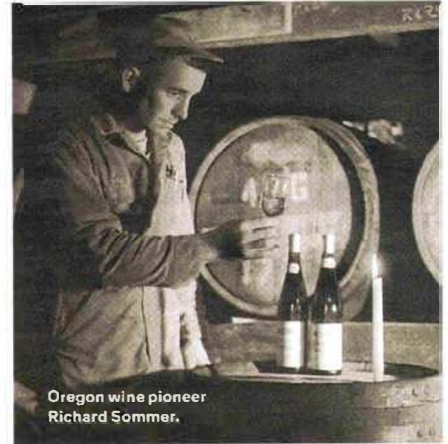

Oregon wine pioneer  
Richard Sommer.

As with California, Oregon's winemaking history is tied to the western expansion that occurred in the late 1840s. Prohibition shut down all serious wine production completely until 1961, when UC Davis grad Richard Sommer (who bottled Oregon's first vintage of Pinot Noir in 1967) began experimental plantings of Riesling, Gewürztraminer, Chardonnay, Semillon, Sauvignon Blanc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir, Malbec and Zinfandel. Throughout the early '60s, Sommer was followed by David Lett, Charles and Shirley Coury and Dick Erath, all of them UC Davis-trained winemakers who disagreed with the notion that fine wine couldn't be produced north of Napa Valley. They soon demonstrated that the rolling hills of Oregon were indeed ideal for creating world-class wines.



Oregon's vineyards are planted on the western side of the Cascade Mountain range, and the varied topography and conditions support more than 50 grape varieties. Oregon's reputation as a top-tier winemaking region rests solidly on **Pinot Noir**. And though Pinot's Burgundian partner, **Chardonnay**, also does very well here, it's **Pinot Gris** that is Oregon's leading white grape. Oregon's ability to produce refined wines of great purity and provenance has attracted considerable international investment and development, including the Drouhin family of Burgundy fame.



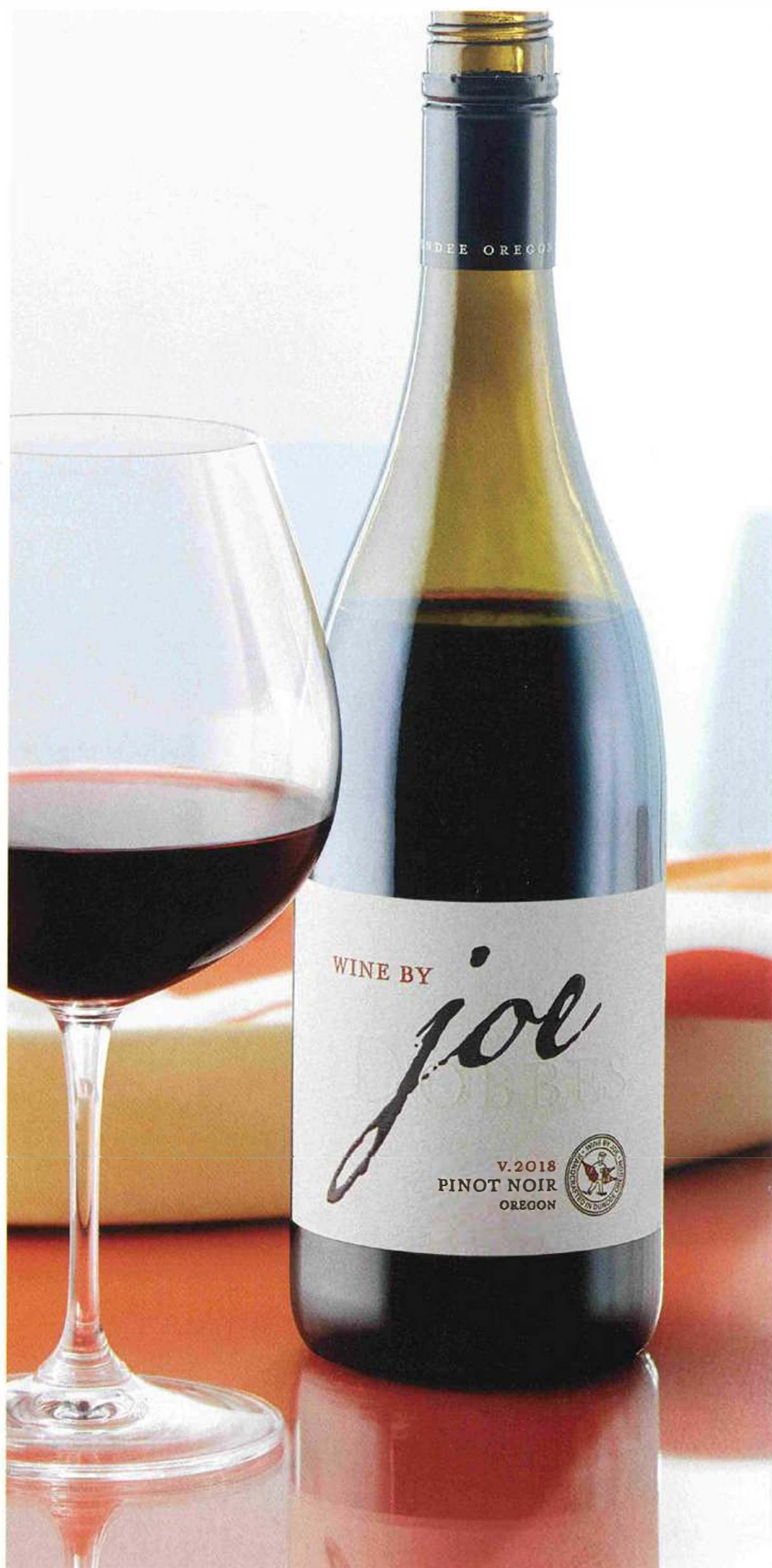

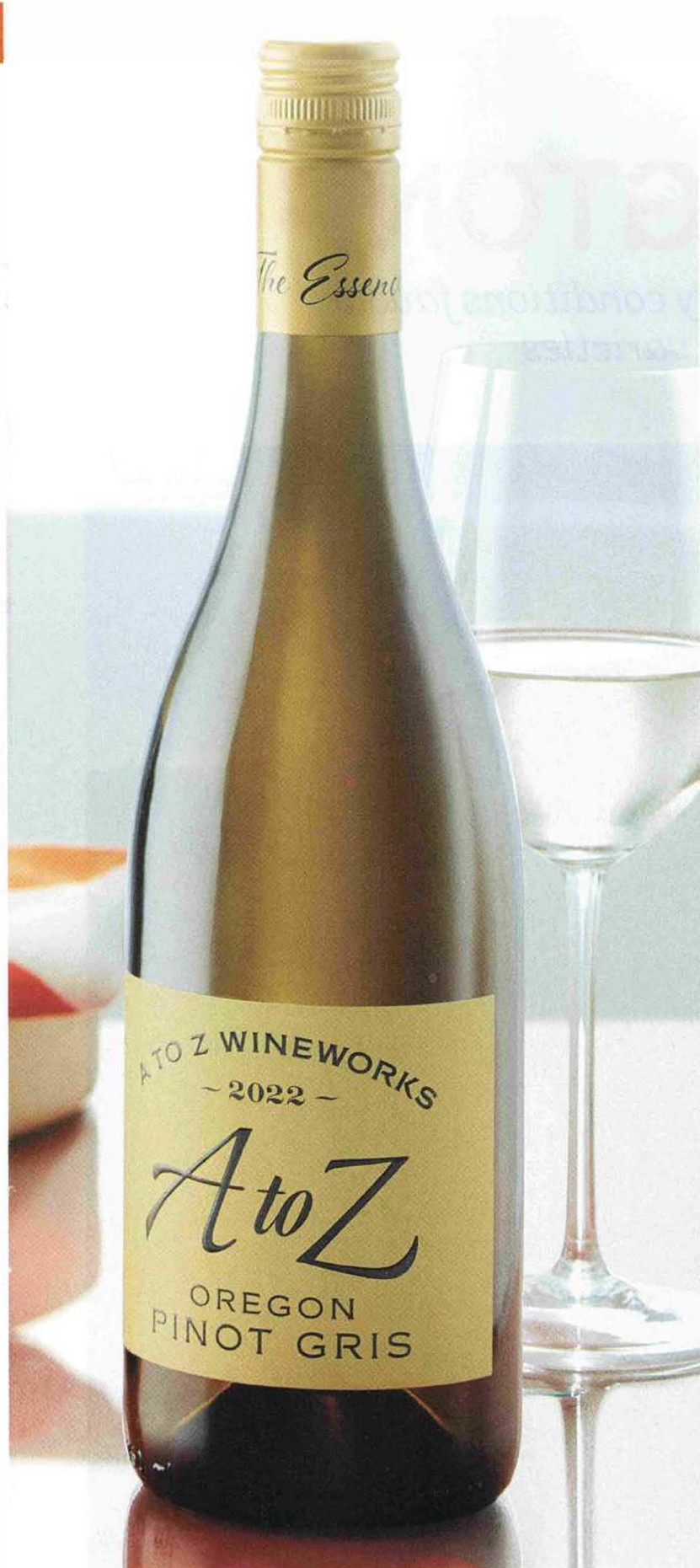

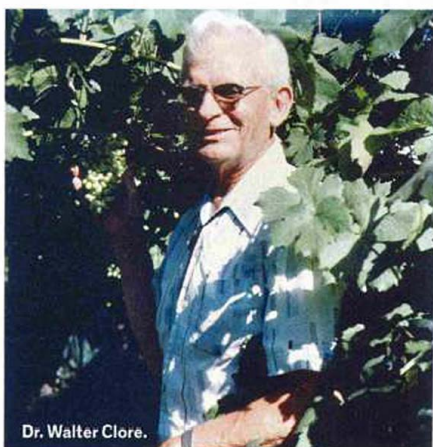

# WASHINGTON

*Warm, dry conditions favour  
Bordeaux varieties*



Grapes were first planted in Washington in 1825, and though there was an enthusiasm for producing wines here, there was little momentum to Washington winemaking as many fledgling vineyards and wineries regularly fell victim to the state's harsh winters. Enter Dr. Walter Clore: a teetotaler who was named the Father of Washington Wine by the state senate in 2003. Clore arrived in Washington in 1934 and began research into growing vegetables and fruit, including grapes. He became convinced that, though vulnerable, premium winemaking could thrive given careful site selection. He shifted his focus to winemaking.

By 1974, Dr. Clore and his team (which included Washington's oldest winery, Chateau Ste. Michelle, for whom he was a consultant) had planted and tested 300 grape varieties in various locations and conditions. His meticulous, scientific approach identified areas where the likes of **Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, Chardonnay** and **Riesling** would produce premium-quality fruit. Washington's vineyards are found to the west of the Cascade Mountains where, unlike in Oregon, conditions are warm and dry. Bordeaux varieties do exceptionally well here, and Washington's red blends are simply outstanding.

# NEW YORK

*Water-moderated terroir is a haven for Riesling*

Wine was first made in New York by Dutch and Huguenot settlers in the 1800s. The state now ranks third in total production in the US, behind only California and Washington, though the majority are native or hybrid varieties designated for juice and sacramental wines. Positioned between the Atlantic Ocean and the Great Lakes, New York's wine region is dotted with small lakes and rivers that play a significant role in moderating local temperatures. There are 10 AVAs within New York, the most prestigious being Finger Lakes, which has similar soils and weather conditions to those in Niagara. Fans of Niagara will therefore not be surprised to hear that Finger Lakes produces exquisite **Chardonnay, Cabernet Franc, Pinot Noir and Riesling**. The latter has become the region's star grape, with high-scoring, cellar-worthy versions being produced in all styles.

Cool-climate Chardonnay is crisp, clean and shows off a precise sense of place. Here are four outstanding Ontario takes on this popular style.

Ontario produces some of the finest (and best-suited-for-summer) Chardonnays on the planet. We spoke to a handful of Niagara winemakers who shared their take on what makes these wines so special.

"Chardonnay is grown all over the world, and what really makes it special is that it has an incredible transparency to showcase place," explains **Westcott** winemaker Casey Kulczyk. "Here in Ontario, we have all the hallmarks of a cool climate, which allows Chardonnay to develop bright acidity, nuanced aromatics, and a level of harvest maturity that offers great texture and balance."

"Ontario has an amazing cool climate that is perfect for ripening Chardonnay," agrees **Leaning Post** winemaker and partner Ilya Senchuk. "We get the whole package of fantastic flavour concentration and density along with freshness and acidity. We also have the perfect soils for Chardonnay; although there are varied topsoils, we have limestone at the base

of almost all of Niagara, which tends to give us a real energy and vibrancy in the wines."

"Here in Niagara, we have a unique terroir with proximity to Lake Ontario and the Niagara Escarpment providing a moderating effect on Chardonnay," says **Stratus** winemaker Dean Stoyka. "During budbreak, the escarpment to the south traps in warmer airflows and protects Chardonnay from spring frosts that can be detrimental to Chardonnay bud survivability in other parts of the world. In summer, when the daytime temperatures begin to rise, we get a prevailing wind coming off the lake that cools the vineyards and keeps the vines in the ideal ripening zone for Chardonnay. This constant airflow is essential to

moderating our daytime and nighttime temperatures and keeps the humidity out of the canopy, which is great for Chardonnay development."

"When I moved to Ontario from Chablis in France 23 years ago," recalls **13th Street** winemaker Jean-Pierre Colas, "people greeted me with these words: Welcome to the extremes. I've had the opportunity to vinify Chardonnay in France, Argentina, Chile, New York and New Zealand, but nowhere has the extremes of weather and the extreme diversity of soils as we do here in Niagara. As a winemaker, you have to be humble. No two vintages are the same, but that's part of what's so exciting about wine."
