

Grace and power

BERTANI CATULLO VALPOLICELLA RIPASSO CLASSICO SUPERIORE 2019

DOC, Veneto, Italy 17777 (XD) 750 mL \$26.95

An atypically light colour for Ripasso, aged in large format French wood following fermentation on pomace of Amarone Classico for one month. This is excellent. There is little to bring awareness to dried fruit characteristics, such is the purity and transparency. A wine of verve, fecund strawberry flavors, a lilt of bergamot and deft levels of concentration. Yet so light on its feet as it pirouettes through the mouth with a mineral twirl and a saline spurt across the long finish. An easy substitute for a quality Burgundy. Drink or hold. Score: 95 (Ned Goodwin, MW, jamessuckling.com, May 9, 2023)



A blend of 60% Grenache, 20% Mourvèdre, 15% Syrah, and the rest Clairette, it has a spicy, red and black-fruited, leather, and dried flower-driven bouquet as well as medium-bodied richness and depth on the palate. With fine tannins and a terrific sense of purity and elegance, enjoy bottles over the coming 4-6 years. It's a yearin, year-out, smoking value. Maturity: 2023-2029. 





AP, Rhône

Beautiful red and black berries, pepper, violets, and a kiss of salty sea breeze all emerge on the nose of the 2021 Costières De Nîmes Héritage, which is medium-bodied, has a supple, elegant mouthfeel, good density, and outstanding length. Based on 60% Grenache, 25% Mourvèdre, and the rest Syrah, this was partially destemmed and brought up 25% in barrel, with the balance in concrete tanks. Score: 89 (jebdunnuck.com, Nov. 2, 2023)

### DOMAINE DES TERRES GENTILLES PINOT NOIR 2021

AP Bourgogne, Burgundy


Pinot Noir is an extremely fickle grape that requires a lot of care and attention to produce great wines, meaning it usually fetches a high price. Offering notes of ripe red cherry, strawberry and mushroom with a fine minerality, this lovely example from a respected domaine shows the desirable characteristics of Burgundy Pinot Noir at a great price.

Burgundy specializes in the thinskinned varieties Pinot Noir and Gamay. Burgundian Pinot tends to be floral and earthy, while their Gamay is fruity and easygoing. These are wines designed for roast chicken or mushroom risotto. Bordeaux deftly balances the thick-skinned, heavier grapes of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot. The broad-shouldered Bordelais blends offer a nuanced, complex bouquet of aromas thanks to extensive ageing in oak barrels and fare well with steak au poivre or black-bean burgers. Côtes du Rhône focuses on firm, boisterous wines made from Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Noted for their spicy, meaty character, these wines pair wonderfully with rack of lamb or eggplant lasagna.







### CHÂTEAU DE MONTFAUCON LA CÔTE CÔTES DU RHÔNE 2019 AP. Rhône


(Translated from the French) This attractive Rhone wine blends five grape varieties into a symphony that opens with a refined nose of stewed raspberries and garrigue and refreshing notes of menthol. The long ageing of 24 months in vats has produced a perfectly balanced palate. Juicy red fruits and hints of tobacco contribute lingering scents to the sweet and subtly tannic mouthfeel. Spices appear on the finish, adding complexity. A mature wine that retains good ageing potential. [Drink till 2028.] Score: \*\*\*



### **WOMEN IN WINE**

## Solicantus: Uprooted, uplifted.

Breaking into an industry that has thousands of years of history, dynasties and châteaux is no easy feat. It's even harder when you're a woman and a person of colour native to a country that doesn't specialize in wine.

Despite all that, nothing deterred Namratha Prashanth's entrepreneurial spirit. Prashanth was always passionate about wine (she had learned about wine and viticulture through her college hospitality program), but life had other plans. She was in the predicament of being married into a staunchly traditionalist, patriarchal household that stunted her growth.


After leaving her situation and moving to Bordeaux, finding work was difficult. She learned all about wine-growing and harvest as an apprentice for Château Siran in the Médoc.


Later, she learned to make wine under the wing of Château Bel-Air La Royère winemaker Corinne Chevrier-Loriaud, who allowed a few of her parcels of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec to be used for Prashanth's own wine.

The pair created Solicantus: a celebration of terroir, harmony, determination and perseverance.

# WHITE KNIGHTS





France is a master class on the importance of origin, which is why they created the Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée (AOC) system. Developed in 1924 and put into law in 1935, the AOC system was designed to protect the consumer from fraudulent bottles and assure a level of quality to be expected from the stated region.



### JOSEPH CATTIN **GEWURZTRAMINER 2022**

Sustainable, AC Alsace

The German grapes grown in Alsace offer more perfumed aromas and bolder flavours than their finely detailed German counterparts. This aromatic, spicy example is full of flavour, with notes of pineapple, lychee, ginger root and chamomile. From the renowned Cattin family, it's a good example of Alsatian quality without the price tag.


Take **Chablis**, which is one of the finest Chardonnay-producing regions in the world. Chablisien wines are light, crisp, steely, and laced with fine minerality thanks to the area's Kimmeridgian soils, which are composed of ancient seashell, limestone, and marl. This makes a nicely chilled glass of Chablis the perfect match for sushi or the traditional pairing of **escargots**. Or how about **Alsace**? Famous for its architecture, the region is a mosaic of complex soils and sports both German and French varieties such as Riesling, Gewürztraminer, and Pinot Blanc. These wines make an excellent accompaniment to a **garden salad topped with goat cheese**. These familiar grapes are found all over the world, and France shows us it's their origin, their terroir, that makes them so fascinating, wherever they plant their roots.


### CLOSERIE DES ALISIERS BOURGOGNE ALIGOTÉ 2022

AP, Burgundy (Stéphane Brocard)

Chardonnay is the most prominent white grape in Burgundy, but small villages will offer the lesser-known Aligoté for the adventurous looking for a full wine with subtle flavours. Crafted by the celebrated winemaker Stéphane Brocard, this wine is lovely and well-structured, with notes of quince, cashew, and white tea followed by a smoky finish.



# THINK PINK





Colour in wine is caused by contact with the grape skin. After crushing, the fermenting grape juice will be left with the skins for days to extract colour, flavour, tannins, and other qualities. Rosé is made by shortening the time of skin contact, usually to only 4-12 hours. A good winemaker knows il faut battre le fer tant qu'il est chaud (you must strike while the iron is hot). Timing is everything in rosé winemaking. Though rosé is made all over the world and can be made from nearly any red grape, the rosés from the South of France are considered the benchmark of quality and are made from a blend of Grenache, Syrah, Carignan, Cinsault and Mourvèdre. Rosé's elegance is best enjoyed on the beach, preferably with BBQ shrimp skewers or a salade niçoise, which is why the regions of Provence and Languedoc are ideal for making rosé. Bordering the Mediterranean Sea, these regions emulate that vacation-by-the-beach feeling and craft light, delicate rosés to accompany it, offering aromas of grapefruit, watermelon, strawberry, jasmine oil and lavender.












# SPARKLING PERSONALITIES







Believe it or not, bubbles in wine were considered a fault in the 17th century. Still wines were the expectation from notable regions like Champagne and Burgundy, but winemakers at the time were determined to harness the power of bubbles to their advantage. Vouloir, c'est pouvoir (where there's a will, there's a way), as they might say. After innovative Benedictine monks perfected the méthode champenoise (traditional method), sparkling wine became the most desired wine of the nobility. Many regions around France have since adopted or altered this method to craft their own sparkling wines, called Crémant: Bordeaux crafts lush sparklers made with Sauvignon Blanc and Sémillon, Burgundy makes fruity wine from Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, and Alsace creates aromatic bubbly with Riesling, Pinot Blanc and Auxerrois. French sparkling's brisk acidity and rich texture are great for celebrations, but what truly makes this beloved wine style so incredible is its flexibility to go with virtually any meal. And we do mean virtually any meal; from baked fish with lemon juice to fried chicken and waffles to salty potato chips, the possibilities with sparkling wine are endless.

### LOUIS ROEDERER COLLECTION BRUT PREMIER CHAMPAGNE

A family-run maison de Champagne for many generations, Louis Roederer crafts Champagne in a light style, with floral aromas of jasmine and chamomile and flavours of lemon zest accentuated by a delicate texture.





"Wine-growing and winemaking is incredibly rewarding," says Chris, "but it involves long hours of hard work, and Andrea and I have high standards that often require our team to go the extra mile. We wanted to give back to our team for going well beyond what would normally be expected and helping us create what we feel are truly incredible wines. So we started a wine company with our staff where they make their own wine under a brand and company that they own 100%. Our business supports them by providing much of the infrastructure and capital, but the wines belong to our team and [20% of] sales go directly to them."

This special business model creates a winery where employees "pay more attention to detail, asking questions and being more interested in what we're doing," says Great Heart winemaker Gynore Hendricks. "Everybody works hard and everybody's involved."

Hendricks, who is a graduate of the prestigious Cape Winemakers Guild Protégé Programme, is born and bred in Swartland, where Great Heart and Mullineux & Leeu are based. "Everything that comes out of the Swartland is amazing," she says. "It's a very dry, warm area, but it also has the influence of the Atlantic Ocean and that makes for cooler nights in the summer. The soil types we have here are very unique to the Swartland. The terroir, growing conditions and soil make for spectacular wines."

### Kelly Mason/ Brooke Husband / Queylus

Born and raised in Montreal, Kelly Mason has been with Queylus since 2013, becoming head winemaker in 2018. Kelly specializes in Chardonnay and Pinot Noir and her work in Ontario has included stints with such notables as Tawse and Le Clos Jordanne. Queylus assistant winemaker Brooke Husband graduated from Niagara College's winery and viticulture program in 2018. Brooke has a specific interest in wild-fermented Pinot Noir and Chardonnay and her work saw her awarded the Paul Pender Rising Star Award at the 2023 Ontario Wine Awards. The winning team behind Queylus is rounded out by sales and marketing director Jo Pacinda and administrative director and property manager Theresa Mildenberger.

### Jessica Otting / Tawse

Jessica Otting became assistant winemaker at Tawse in 2018 and was part of the team that established the Tawse spirits program. "My very first harvest I worked for Marlize Beyers at Flat Rock. She was so passionate and willing to throw me into whatever needed doing. She was patient with me even when I was slow or made mistakes. If it weren't for her support, I'm not sure I would have had a chance in this industry." Since 2020. Jessica has overseen winemaking for both Tawse and Redstone wineries. "This industry has come a long way in terms of diversity and inclusion, but we still have so far to go. I believe it's my responsibility as a woman in a leadership position to do what I can to work for all under-represented groups."

### Amélie Boury / Château des Charmes

Amélie Boury grew up on a farm in northern France only 45 minutes from Champagne. Her love affair with wine goes back to her youngest years, when she would be given "a very small Champagne flute by my grandparents for me to cheers with everyone." Amélie's mother encouraged her "to learn the names of plants and to memorize their scents, and my father is a wine aficionado. I became the house expert at describing the scents of flowers. It was this idyllic lifestyle that led me to my initial career as a perfumer. It wasn't long after, however, that my deep connection to the land inspired me to pursue viticulture and oenology, and for 15 years, this has been my career."



### Simone Ardiel / Rockway Vineyards

Simone Ardiel grew up on a fruit farm, where she would help her parents when they made wine and hard cider. After graduating high school, she entered Niagara College's winery and viticulture program. "After graduating, I travelled to hone my winemaking knowledge and experience. Early on in my travels, I worked a harvest in Oregon under Luisa Ponzi at Ponzi Vineyards. Luisa has extensive knowledge in wine and was very family-focused, having four children with her husband while running her family winery, not to mention sitting on several advisory and wine organization boards. Luisa continues to inspire me as I start to grow my own family while I work and build my career."
