Getting down to bizzo in an Australian vineyard.

Across its varied regions, Oz is revealing a subtle shift to lighter, fresher wines and a penchant for winemaking practices that tread lightly on the earth.

Australia has a rich history as a producer of big, bold wines. But the modern Australian wine scene is increasingly diverse, yielding a range of styles from classically bold and powerful to intricately nuanced and elegant, all crafted from an expansive palette of grape varieties. Even better, a growing number of producers are embracing sustainable farming and winemaking methods. Read on for the lowdown on what they're up to Down Under.

SHIRAZ

Elegant and structured

The undisputed signature wine grape of Australia, Shiraz built a reputation over the years for big, ripe wines. And while those wines remain popular, modern Australian vintners have expanded their repertoire with the variety. Today, you also find more elegantly structured Shiraz from cooler climates such as Adelaide Hills, Clare Valley and Eden Valley, with some producers even using the variety to make wonderfully nuanced pink wines. And of course, beloved styles such as sparkling Shiraz and GSM (blends featuring Grenache, Shiraz and Mataro) continue to thrive.



THOMAS GOSS SHIRAZ 2022

McLaren Vale, South Australia

Richly fruited and inviting, showing blackberry, rich floral, star anise and hazelnut aromas on the nose, leading to a generously flavoursome palate, delivering silky texture and beautifully infused tannins. Wonderfully composed and expressed, finishing persistent and satisfying. At its best: now to 2030. Score: **93** (Sam Kim, wineorbit.co.nz, Oct. 2024)

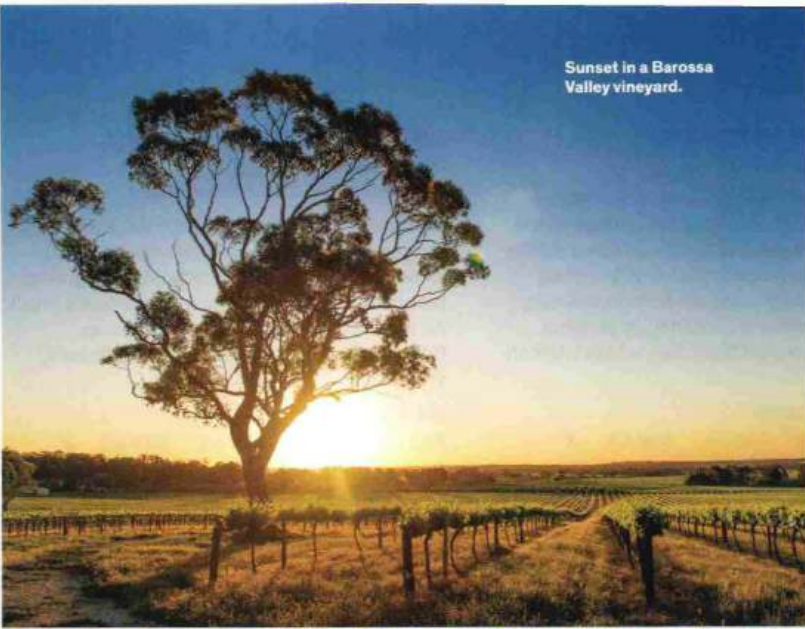

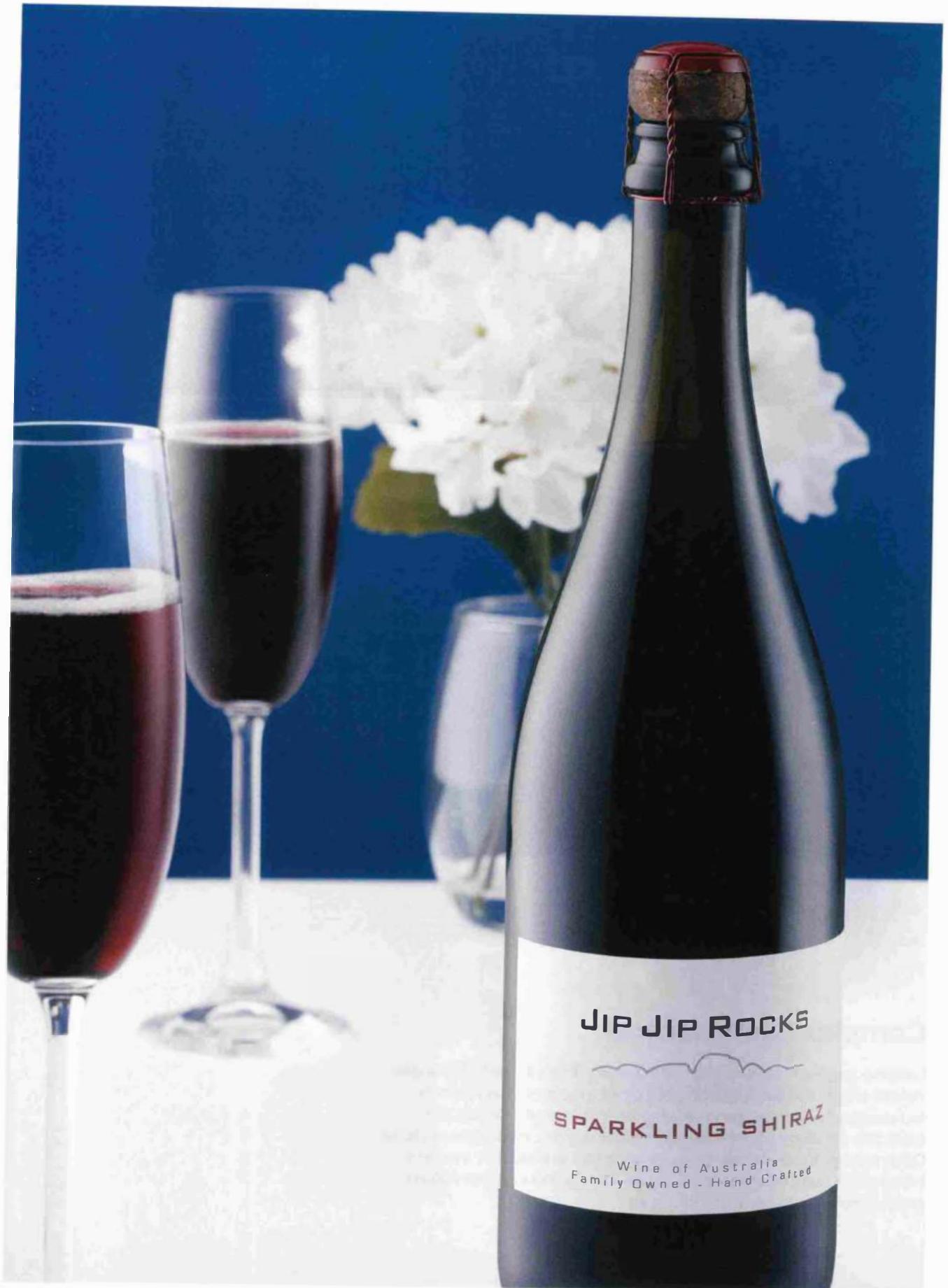

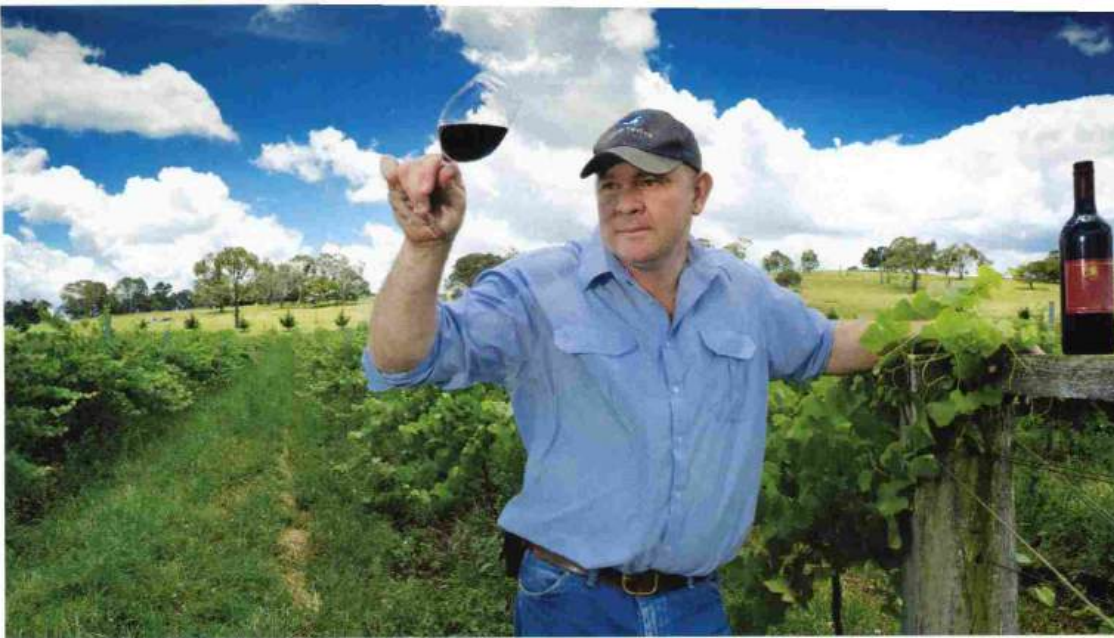

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Complex and balanced

Long the grape of choice in Western Australia, where it's prized in single-varietal wines or in Bordeaux-inspired blends, Cabernet Sauvignon is increasingly finding a niche in other corners of Australia. Results are especially exciting in mountainous or coastal regions, where, like in classic Cabernet regions such as Bordeaux and Napa, the altitude or maritime influence (or both) allow the grape to ripen slowly and evenly to achieve great complexity, balance and structure.

Limestone Coast, South Australia, vegan

It's varietally expressive and well defined by firm structure, showing blackcurrant, tobacco, pepper spice and cedary oak characters on the nose. 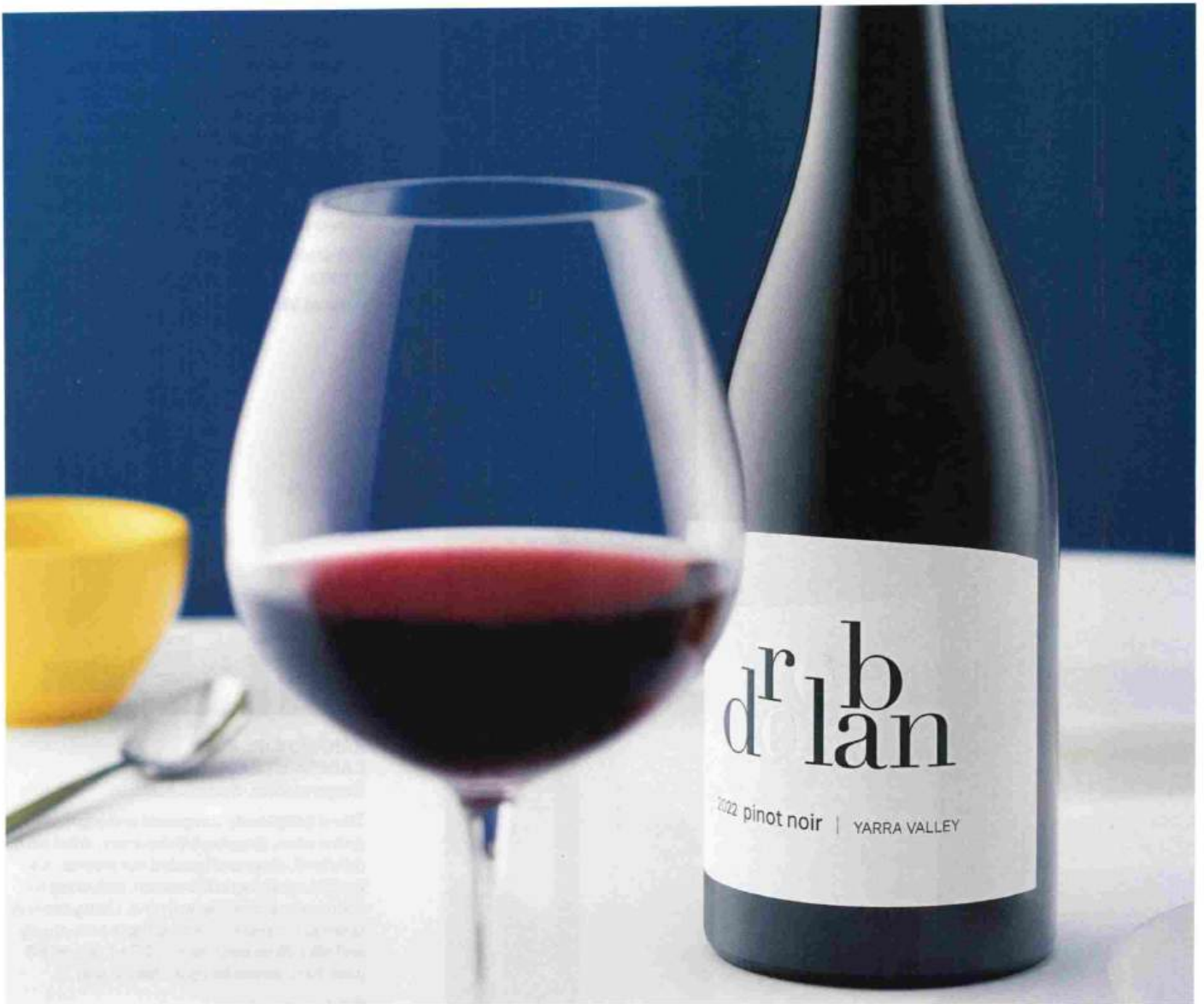

PINOT NOIR

Expressive and nuanced

Famously fickle and exacting, Pinot Noir requires the precise conditions of a cool climate with just the right soil types in which to thrive. While historically this limited the variety mostly to the island of Tasmania and the coastal region of Victoria at Australia's southeastern tip, dedicated producers have diligently sought out Pinot-friendly vineyards in other parts of the country. Wines grown at higher altitudes in such places as Adelaide Hills, Clare Valley and Eden Valley are increasingly impressive.

Seductively complex and sensually appealing, the wine shows dark plum, roasted hazelnut, porcini and rich floral aromas on the nose. 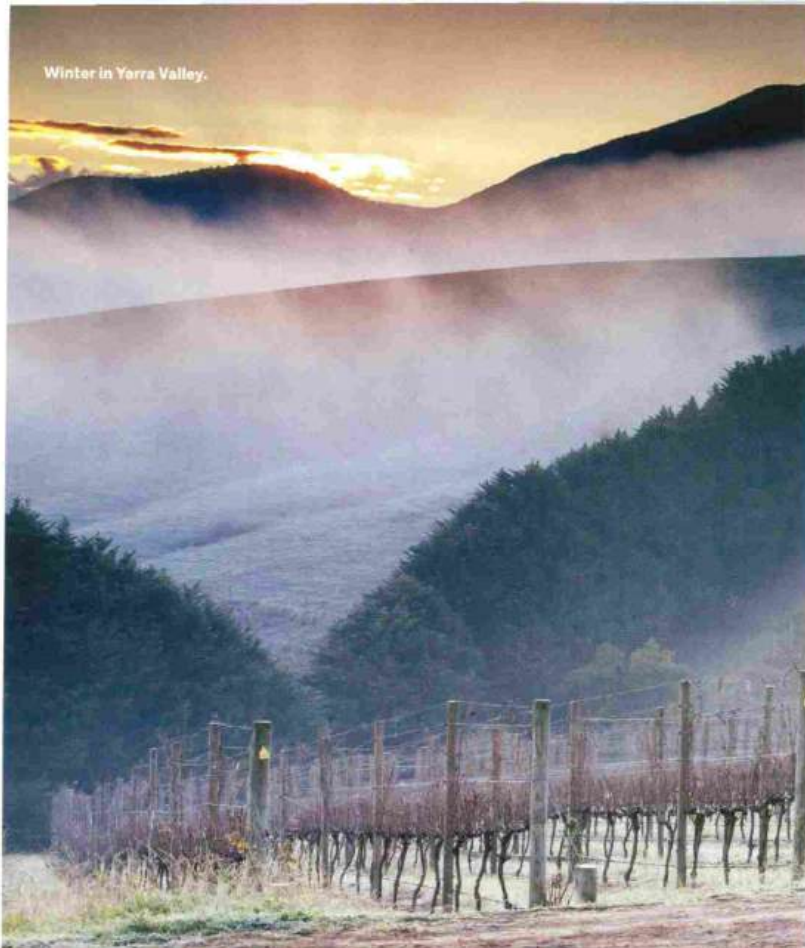

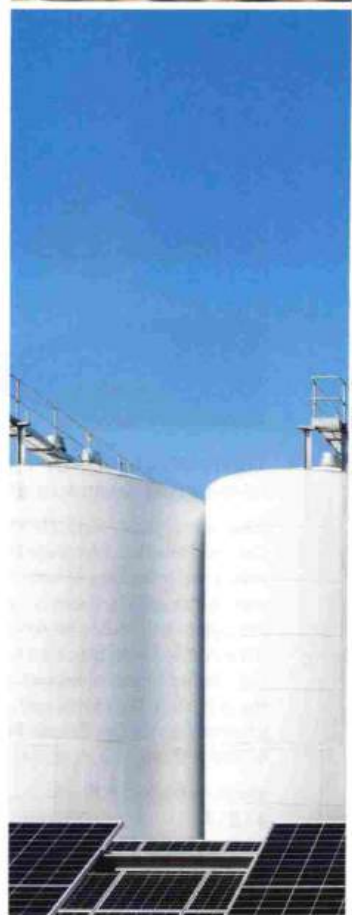

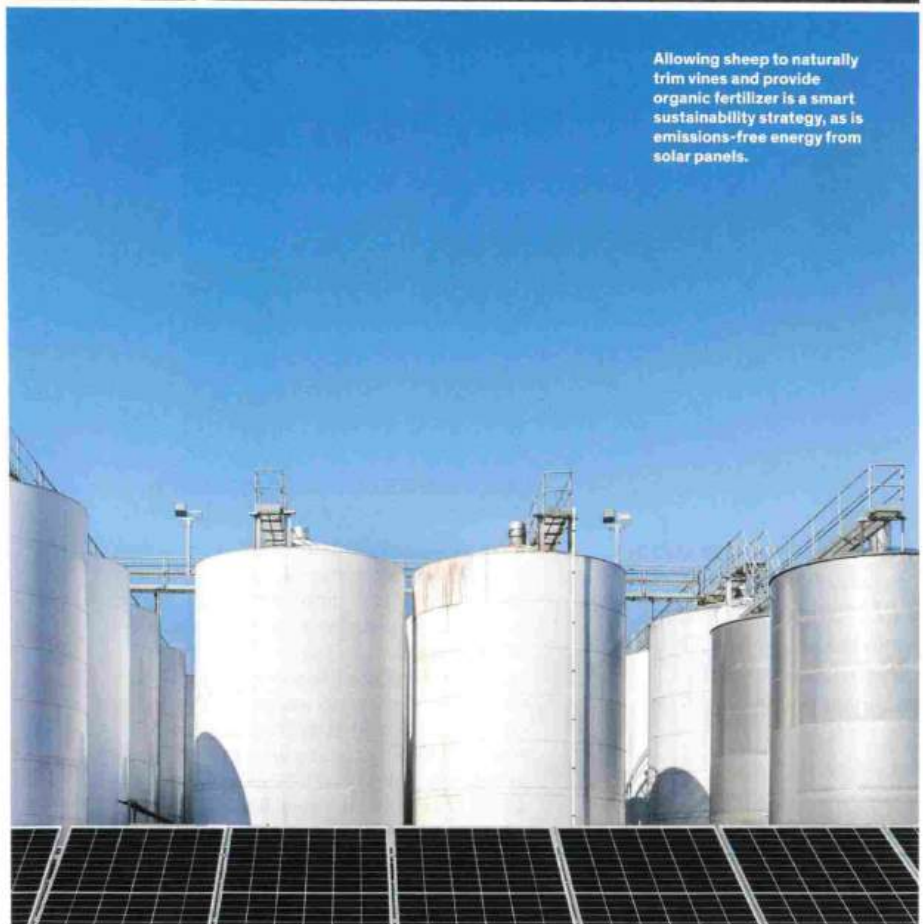
SUSTAINABILITY STALWART

The sustainability movement is finding traction in Australia's modern wine scene. At the heart of these efforts is Sustainable Winegrowing Australia: a voluntary national program to which an increasing number of growers and winemakers are adhering. The program aims to promote sustainability in the vineyard and winery through the environmental, social and economic aspects of businesses. An impressive 50% of its members are now certified, which represents a 235% growth in vineyard certification and 143% growth in winery certification in the 18 months ending in December 2023. To qualify for the Sustainable Winegrowing Australia Certified trust mark use on a wine label, 85% of the grapes in the bottle must be from a certified vineyard and processed in a certified winery. RIESLING

Restrained and delicate

Another grape that favours a cool climate, Riesling is a signature variety in Victoria. With its wonderful ability to express minerality, it's also becoming a specialty in the rocky hills of Victoria's Strathbogie Ranges. Depending on where it's grown and how it's handled in the vineyard and winery, Riesling can create wines ranging from bracingly bone-dry to richly sweet and everything in between. In the hands of skilled winemakers, these can be wines that last for decades.

MAC FORBES RS15 RIESLING 2022 Strathbogie Ranges, Yarra Valley, Victoria

From a vineyard planted in 1982. Fermented in a mix of concrete and seasoned oak, matured in concrete for six months. A pale, bright green gold. Very restrained with its delicate bouquet of green apple, nashi pear and pink grapefruit. Chalky textured, finely detailed and with balanced and perfectly integrated acidity, you'd struggle to guess that this has 15g/L of RS. A beautifully put-together wine that should age effortlessly. 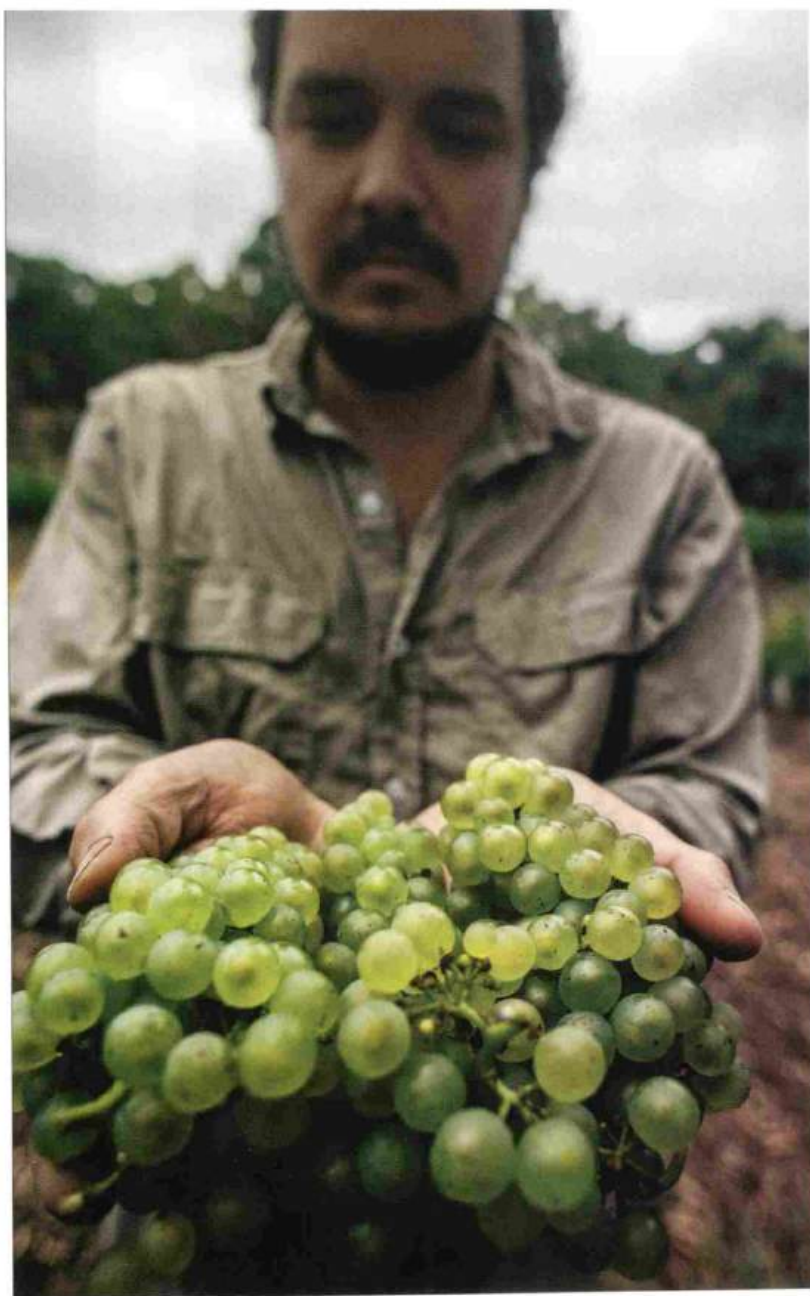

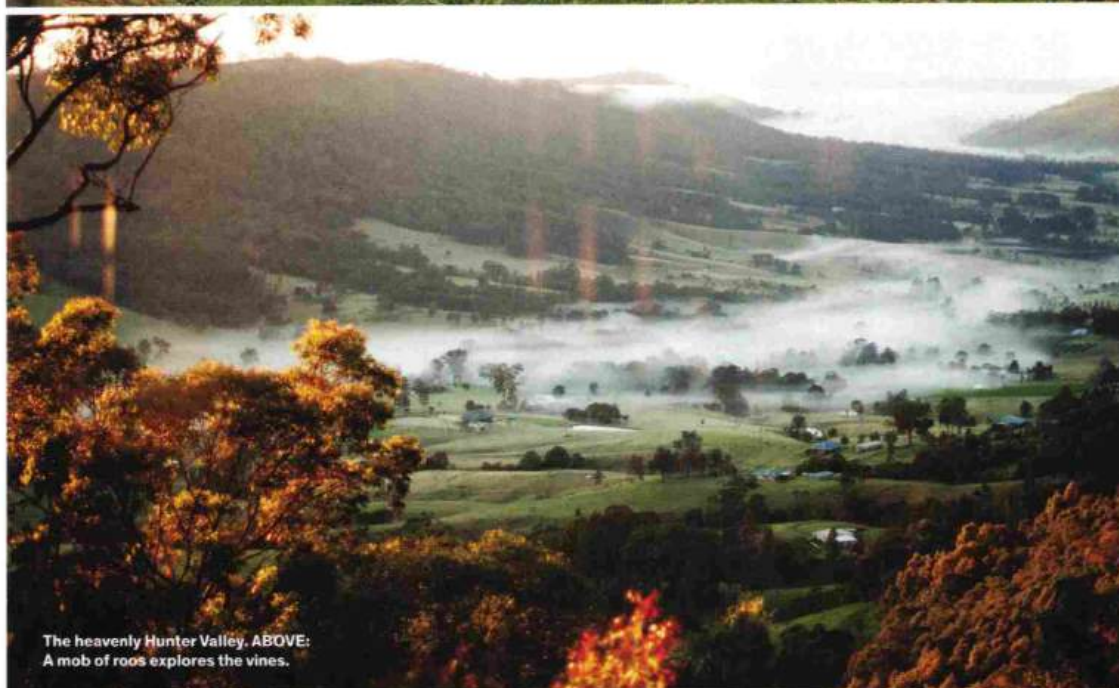

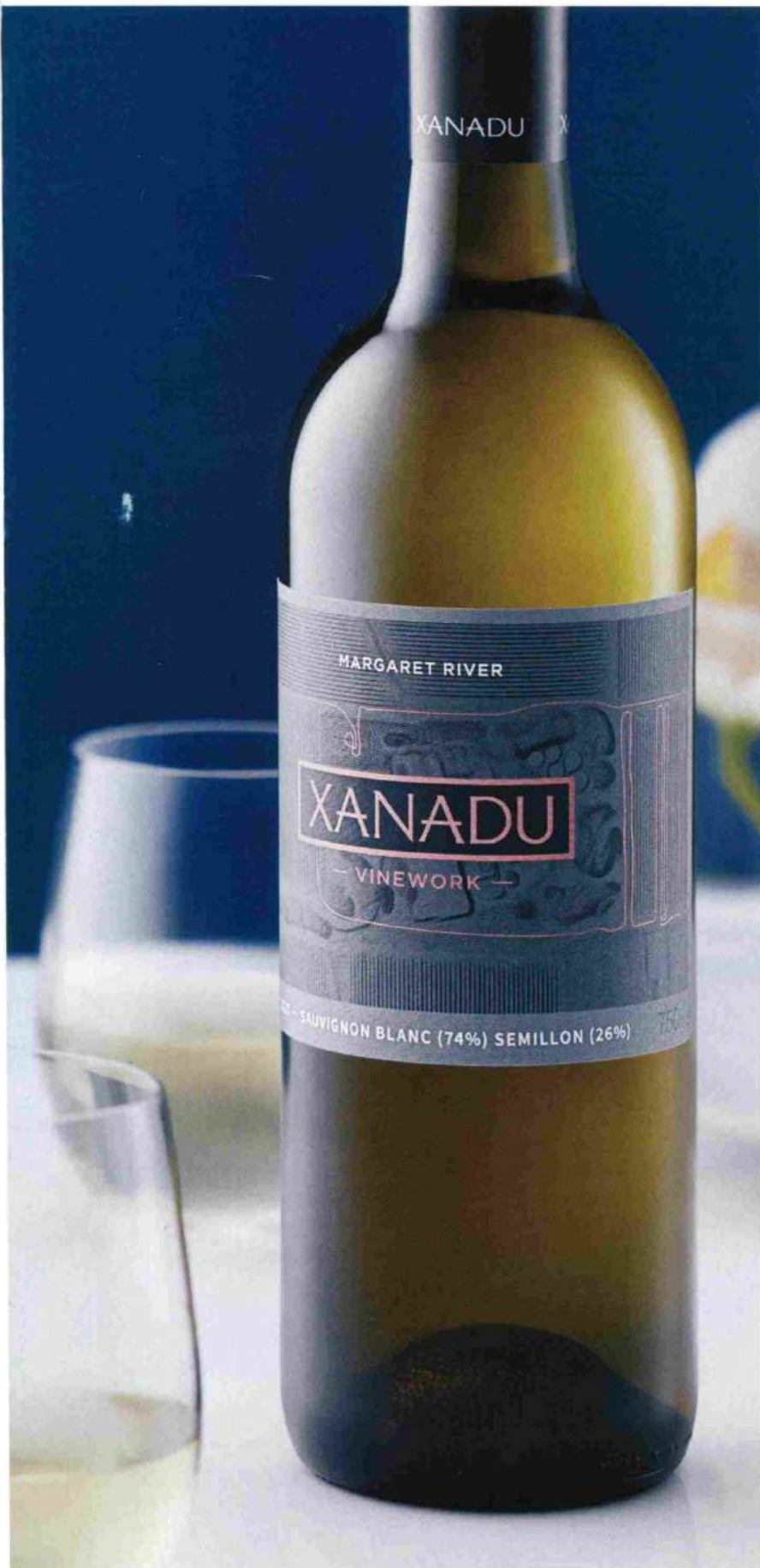

SEMILLON

Distinctive and long-lived

If Australia has a signature white wine variety, the honour probably goes to Semillon. The grape has been used for generations in the Hunter Valley to create distinctively complex, long-lived wines that are unquestionably the region's claim to fame. Semillon can also thrive in other parts of Australia, and in some corners of the country is frequently found blended with Sauvignon Blanc, much like the classic white wines of Bordeaux.



TYRRELL'S HUNTER VALLEY SEMILLON 2023

Hunter Valley, New South Wales

The opening act to a wonderful suite. Mostly HVD sourcing. Riffs on lemon grass, lime drop, pistachio husk, spa salts and nettle. Light-weighted and effusive of freshness. A little more open-knit and herbaceous, pungent and bright, than the more reticent wines of the upper tier. All the better for breaching earlier. A drape of subtle sweetness across the finish. Meet Steve Byfield, proprietor
of Nyarai Cellars, Canada's only
Black-owned wine label.

Nyarai (na-rye) Cellars is a virtual winery owned and operated by Steve Byfield, who released his first wines in 2009. When Byfield began Nyarai, it was one of only three virtual wineries in Niagara. Virtual wineries operate without owning their own vineyards or winemaking facilities, and the unique, dynamic expressions they create offer important insights into the character of a wine region.

For Byfield, the journey to becoming a winemaker “began around 1996, while I was at university studying to become a music teacher,” he says. “To earn some extra money, I took a part-time job at the Brew Factory [a do-it-yourself beer and winemaking business]. For the first time, I learned about different wine grapes and the various styles of wine that could be made. I was really interested.”

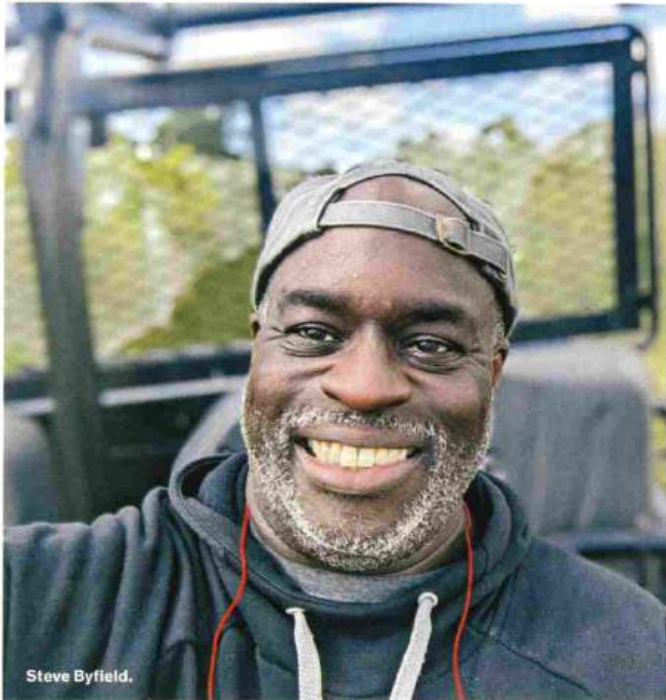
Byfield quickly demonstrated an affinity for winemaking, so much so that it led him to take a chance on a change of vocational direction. Following graduation, he applied to four local wineries and was hired by Southbrook Vineyards as a product consultant. “In 2001, I was made an apprentice cellar hand, and then after a short time, assistant winemaker.” The hands-on experience he was getting at Southbrook was reinforced by a return to school, this time with a wine focus. “There was a lot to learn, but I knew that this was what I wanted

to do. I worked at Southbrook for five vintages and spent time with other wineries, including Ridgepoint and Calamus.”

Inspired by his successes and a desire to continue to challenge himself, Byfield decided to strike out and create his own label. Though encouraged by others to use his own name for his new brand, Byfield searched for one that seemed to better describe what he was attempting to do. “Nyarai” comes from the Shona people of Southern Africa and means “humility” in the Bantu language. “I loved the name. It touches my ethnicity, and winemaking will definitely humble you.”

The two wines showcased here reflect the personal side of Nyarai for Byfield. The Cadence 2021 “is a red blend that was inspired by my love for Bordeaux varietals, which was cultivated during my time at Southbrook. I’m a Bordeaux freak. Those are the grapes I was really excited to work with when I started Nyarai.

“In 2020, after the death of George Floyd and everything that was happening around that, I was stuck to my TV and my phone trying to get information. I was feeling helpless and hurt. I kept thinking about my parents, who are Jamaican, and all that they went through in the 1960s. I kept thinking: why are we going backwards? I wanted to make a contribution to that moment, put something out there that said, ‘this is my voice, this is who

I am.' So I made the Folklore Sparkling to celebrate all those who came before me and so that everyone can do the same with their families." Folklore Sparkling was first released in February of 2021.

"Despite the fact that I may be the only person of Afro-Canadian heritage working in the Canadian wine industry as a winemaker, and more notably the proprietor of the country's only Black-owned wine company, I am truly blessed to be a member of Niagara's dynamic community of gifted artisans. So many have shown mentorship and support for my work, and without their help, my journey to this place in time would not have been possible. Respectfully, I would like to acknowledge some people who were fundamental in my career. First, Dan and Elsa Byfield, my parents; and my three siblings. And I want to mention Bill and Marilyn Redelmeier of Southbrook Vineyards, Mauro Scarsellone of Ridgepoint Wines and veteran Niagara winemaker Derek Barnett. And, of course, my incredible and supportive team at Nyarai Cellars who have given their blood, sweat, and tears to Nyarai. No amount of words can express my sincere gratitude and appreciation for your friendship and unwavering support. It has made our company what it is."

Humility indeed.
