In wine regions around the world, eco-minded producers are adopting organic, sustainable and biodynamic practices and proving that green is good for the planet and your palate.

Winemakers are obsessed with the pursuit of purity, always striving to express the authentic character of their wines. This quest has fostered generations of experimentation and risk-taking, and led to the realization that the less one meddles with wines, the better they taste. Through the use of such things as cover crops, integrated pest management, natural fertilizers and animal-based manures, wineries are creating healthier vineyards and, in turn, better-tasting wines. Wineries don't go "green" on a whim; the expense and time demanded when adhering to organic, biodynamic and sustainable viticulture regulations is considerable, but the payoff is a legacy of environmental and economic viability encapsulated in wines of the highest possible quality. At LCBO, we're also focusing on building a more sustainable future through a new initiative called Spirit of Sustainability (see page 28). We're proud to shine the spotlight on this collection of delicious wines perfect for celebrating Earth Day.



ORGANIC / pure and simple

One of the buzziest of buzzwords these days is "organic," but despite organic winemaking's popularity, understanding what it means isn't always straightforward. Some of the key confusions surround labelling. For example, what's the difference between "organic" and "made with organically grown grapes"? To earn either designation, 100% of the grapes must be grown without the use of chemical pesticides, herbicides or synthetic fertilizers. But the difference between the two centres on the percentage of sulfites (SO₂ measured in parts per million) used during vinification. Sulfites occur naturally, in small amounts, during the fermentation process, making it virtually impossible to create wines that contain none, but winemakers often add SO₂ to help prevent oxidation and unwanted bacteria, particularly for delicate white wines. To be labelled as organic, wines must contain less than 250 ppm of SO₂. Wines designated as "made with organically grown grapes" will have slightly more. For context, non-organic wines can have up to 400 ppm of SO₂.

I Giusti & Zanza use "green manure" to fertilize their soils. These are cover crops specifically planted for the purpose of adding nutrients and organic matter to the soil. Green manure can be as effective as animal manure.

A many-splendoured thing

Since many wineries use a combination of organic, sustainable and/or biodynamic practices, the wines in this feature may fall under one or more of these categories and are not necessarily associated only with the practice described on the page where they appear.



Then... what's natural wine?

While there's no formal certification for natural wine, it's typically produced with minimal intervention. There can be no pesticide or herbicide use, no additives, the grapes must be hand-picked, and fermentation must be triggered by native yeasts (those found naturally on the grapes, not introduced). Natural wines often have intriguing flavours and textures all their own and many benefit from decanting.









BIODYNAMIC / turning organic up a notch

Biodynamic and organic winemaking follow a similar approach. For example, chemical or synthetic fertilizers, pesticides and fungicides aren't permitted in either. However, biodynamics takes organic practices to their highest levels. **Biodynamics cares for the vineyard as a single organism, emphasizing biodiversity** and taking a holistic view of the land and the creatures and plants on it. It's tuned to astrological influences and lunar cycles, with planting, pruning and harvesting determined by, and coordinated with, the phases of the moon. One common misconception about organic and biodynamic wines is that they're automatically vegan, but if your wine doesn't state so specifically, it may not be; egg whites and animal enzymes are allowed in organic wines. Biodynamic practices include burying cow horns filled with manure compost to give back to the soil, fulfilling a central tenet of biodynamics in which the vineyard is viewed as a closed circle.





GRGICH HILLS ESTATE GROWN CHARDONNAY 2016

Made with organic grapes, Napa Valley, California

Committed to sustainability and natural winemaking, Grgich Hills farms their five estate vineyards without artificial fertilizers, pesticides or herbicides and wild ferments all of their wines. The winery has been solar powered since 2006.

SUSTAINABLE / a multi-layered approach

Sustainable winemaking takes an even broader approach than organic or biodynamic winemaking, though many producers practice all three. The overarching philosophy here is to create the best wines possible while striving for economic viability and social responsibility, all in an ecologically responsible manner that ensures a positive environmental legacy. Sustainability looks beyond the needs of individual vineyards to the employees, communities and even people who visit the winery. Not surprisingly, many of the practices overlap with organic and biodynamic farming; the use of integrated pest management, cover crops, composting, recycling, the preservation of local ecosystems and wildlife habitats, and water and energy conservation are all key elements of a sustainable approach. Sustainability is especially important in places such as Chile, New Zealand and South Africa, where it has become an integral part of each country's winemaking identity. Here in Ontario, the practice is being adopted by more and more wineries.





HIDDEN BENCH FUMÉ BLANC 2018 *

Rosomel Vineyard, VQA Beamsville Bench, Niagara Escarpment, Ontario

Hidden Bench has been certified organic since 2013, and they've undertaken a number of sustainable winemaking practices as well. 

Sicily's winemaking heritage dates back over 30 centuries, and little wonder. Warm and dry with plenty of consistent sunshine and reliable growing conditions, Sicily is a great place to make wine. Winemakers here rarely use any form of chemical intervention in the vineyards, as the perfect climate and influence of sea breezes mean there's little or no disease pressure on the vines and virtually no concern for the development of rot or fungus. Sicily's dynamic wine future is being defined by the success of indigenous grapes such as Nero d'Avola and Grillo as well as rejuvenated ancient grapes such as Catarratto, Inzolia and Frappato. But the top-flight conditions also allow for impressive, characterful Chardonnay and Cabernet Sauvignon. Winemakers here have pursued aggressive experimentation in organic and biodynamic farming, seeking to push Sicily's natural advantages to even greater heights. Many of the most distinct and sensational wines are sourced from mineral-rich volcanic soils, such as those surrounding Mount Etna. The fiercely independent spirit of the wines made here is a commanding reflection of the proud, distinctive character of this place and its people.

STEMMARI GRILLO 2018

Sustainably farmed, DOC Sicilia

TASTING NOTE: Grillo is arguably the most important white grape in Sicily. Native to the island, it flourishes in sites with sandy soils and plenty of sunshine. Sardinia's position in the Mediterranean between Spain, France, Algeria and Italy made it an important site for trade in antiquity and afforded it strategic military value. Over the centuries, the island fell to a number of kingdoms and world powers, and its wines reflect this volatile past. Today, Sardinia's wines share little in common with those of the Italian mainland; instead, they've been more acutely influenced by France and Spain, as evidenced by the Cabernet Sauvignon, Cannonau (Grenache) and Carignan planted here. The island also features many ancient grapes, often grown nowhere else, with obscure names such as Torbato, Semidano, Nasco, Monica and Nuragus. The influence of the Mediterranean Sea combined with the diverse soil types, the nuanced variations between coastal and inland growing sites and the variable, hilly topography provide Sardinian producers with exciting opportunities for creating distinct wines from numerous mesoclimates. And as if that wasn't enough, what with its beaches, picturesque towns and stunning scenery, the place is just out-and-out gorgeous.

Rather than using cultured yeast to ferment this Riesling, Organized Crime lets events unfold spontaneously. The yeast they use is native to the vine-yard and goes by many aliases: ambient, local, wild. The result is a fresh, clean, fruity wine that passionately speaks of its origins and its vintage. Maybe crime does pay.
