TASTING NOTE: Tasted out of bottle, the 2018 Côtes Catalanes Tessellae displays a spicy, complex style that carries vivid red and blue fruits, leather, licorice, tree bark, and peppery herbs aromas and flavors. Playing in the more medium-bodied end of the spectrum, it has solid purity of fruit, silky tannins, and a good finish. Enjoy this plump, pleasure-bent effort over the coming 3-4 years. Take a taste trip across the Mediterranean with a glass or two from this collection of sunny, summery wines.

When we daydream about the ideal setting, many of us conjure up warm sun, gorgeous scenery, delicious cuisine, and a lovely glass of wine. In some parts of the world this fantasy is a reality almost all year round, right down to the glassful of locally grown grape-derived glory. We've selected a few fruit-forward, summer-perfect favourites from wine regions of the Mediterranean to bring paradise to you.

At the southernmost point of the Italian Peninsula, where it dips its toe into the heart of the Mediterranean Sea itself, is where you'll find **Calabria**. Shaped by coastlines and interior mountains and lakes, this was the setting of some of Homer's epic tales and houses some of Italy's most stunning beaches and historic architecture, including an 11th-century Romanesque-Gothic cathedral. Bold red wines made from the region's local grapes go beautifully with barbecued pizza, particularly those featuring caramelized red onions, which are a local specialty.



LIBRANDI DUCA SANFELICE CIRÒ RISERVA ROSSO 2017 DOC, Calabria

Composed 100% from the local Gaglioppo grape and matured for three years in stainless steel, this wine will bring plenty of ripe, sunny cherry and strawberry embroidered by spices and backed by velvety tannins. Pair with Calabrian pizza.

Across the Strait of Messina from Calabria is the island of **Sicily**. Immortalized in classic film scenes from *The Godfather*, it's home to Baroque cathedrals carved from red sandstone as well as rich, ripe red wines, the latter a nice pairing for pasta alla Norma with tomatoes, eggplant and garlic. Midway up the Italian mainland coast is **Tuscany**, famed equally for its picturesque villas (as featured in *Under the Tuscan Sun*) and its elegant red wines, which are wonderful partners for pasta Bolognese or steak Florentine.



FEUDO MACCARI SAIA NERO D'AVOLA 2017 DOC Sicilia, Sicily

TASTING NOTE: Fascinating aromas of blackberries, tar, asphalt and flowers. Full body, firm and silky tannins and a bright and fruity finish. Yet in reserve. Needs some time to soften. Better after 2020. Score: **94** (jamessuckling. com, Nov. 7, 2019)

LA MANNELLA ROSSO DI MONTALCINO 2018 DOC, Tuscany

TASTING NOTE: Fruit from the youngest vines (planted in 2011) at the La Mannella site make this unique wine. Not many producers are in a position to make a single-vineyard Rosso, but we are slowly seeing more of them come to market. The Cortonesi 2018 Rosso di Montalcino La Mannella is redolent of red berry fruit, almond and plum. The wine does offer a rather prominent sense of structure, and this is one of the characteristics of the La Mannella site. Drink date: 2020-2024. Score: **91** (Monica Larner, robertparker.com, Jan. 31, 2020)

Known colloquially in French as Midi, the South of France is synonymous with sunshine. Indeed, one can hardly think of the Mediterranean without picturing **Provence** and its romantic seaside villages and sandy beaches along the French Riviera. The inspiration for masterpieces by Cézanne, van Gogh, Renoir and Matisse, this region is also home to vinous virtuosity – especially its seriously seductive rosé wines, which pair wonderfully with salade nicoise, ratatouille or grilled seafood.

CHÂTEAU LA MASCARONNE ROSÉ 2020 AP Côtes de Provence

The previous vintage of this organic-certified rosé made from Cinsault, Grenache, Syrah and Vermentino grown in Provence nabbed 92 points from robertparker.com. Expect this newest vintage to be equally impressive, evoking fresh citrus and crushed stones along with a tantalizing hint of red fruit. It'll pair nicely with grilled lemon-garlic scallops or salade niçoise.

L'OSTAL ROSÉ 2020

IGP Pays d'Oc, Languedoc (Famille J.M. Cazes)

"Ostal" means both "house" and "family" in the ancient Occitan language, which aptly evokes the crowd-pleasing nature of this perennially popular, effortlessly elegant rosé made from half Syrah and half Grenache. Expect inviting aromas and flavours of nectarine, clementine and pomegranate and pair with ratatouille salad or garlic shrimp.

Easygoing & Fruity 450809 (XD) 750 mL \$15.95 To the west along the coast of Southern France is Occitanie, the southernmost region of mainland France, with its component territories of Languedoc and **Roussillon**. This vast, sprawling region stretches from the Mediterranean coast up into central France and is home to Toulouse, whose 240 kilometres of picturesque canals centre around the Canal du Midi, built in 1667 under the auspices of Louis XIV. It's also home to a range of wine styles, including soft, generously fruity red wines that go equally well with charcuterie platters or grilled Toulouse sausages.



PAUL MAS SINGLE VINEYARD COLLECTION RESERVE VIOGNIER 2019 Nicole Vineyard, IGP Pays d'Oc, Languedoc

Paul Mas is one of the most exciting producers in the South of France and works to impart a sense of "luxe rural" (simple luxury) to all of their wines. You'll find this single-vineyard Viognier to be intense and characterful, with an opulently smooth texture and touches of honey, pear, citrus and peach. Ideal for grilled pork or chicken dishes.

CLIMATE KARMA

The classic Mediterranean climate makes for ripe, sunny fruit, which in turn makes for ripe, sunny wines. Red wines made in these regions famously feature ripe fruit flavours and, depending on the grapes used and winemaker style, can range from velvety soft to boldly structured. Grapes for white and rosé wines are typically picked early so the wines retain their natural crispness and brightness while still exhibiting ripe, sunny fruit.

PREDICTABLY PERFECT

Compared with cooler regions, which can be subject to highly unpredictable vintage variation, Mediterranean climates typically experience remarkably reliable sunshine and warm weather. This means the wines are more consistent (and, depending on the grape and the style, more reliably ripe and fruit-forward) year after year.

CHÂTEAU DE MANISSY LE MOULIN DE NOTRE DAME TAVEL 2020 AC, Southern Rhône

Situated across the Rhône River from Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Tavel is famous for its big, bombastic rosé wines. This one is certified organic and biodynamic by Ecocert and Demeter respectively, and the previous vintage was awarded Gold by *Gilbert & Gaillard*. Look for abundant strawberry, watermelon and wild herb notes and pour alongside grilled fish with olive-and-tomato tapenade.



LA CADIÉRENNE CUVÉE GRANDE TRADITION BANDOL ROSÉ 2020 AC, Provence

The rolling vineyards around the Mediterranean coastal town of Bandol in Provence yield some of the most renowned rosés in the world. A blend of Mourvèdre, Grenache and Cinsault, this wine consistently offers ripe peach, pear, wild herbs and tropical fruit in a bright, juicy, sleekly smooth and elegant package. Pair with grilled seafood and summer salads.

Although most of Spain's best-known wine regions are not directly adjacent to the sea, they do feel the effects of the Mediterranean and its eponymous climate. Just south of the French border in Spain's northeast is **Aragón**, with its surging rivers, soaring Pyrenees peaks and medieval monuments. The local red wines here are classic pairings for lamb chilindrón, as well as grilled beef or lamb burgers.





BORSAO ZARIHS 2016

Campo de Borja, Aragón

TASTING NOTE: This red marries the ripe fruit and toasty oak of the international style with a savory, rustic character. A thick, polished texture, supported by well-integrated tannins and balsamic acidity, carries dark plum, black pepper, soy sauce and loamy earth flavors that are seamless and long. Due east of this region is **Ribera del** Duero, situated along its namesake river near the foothills of the Sierra de la Demanda and Sierra de Guadarrama mountain ranges. Here, the historic town of Aranda de Duero houses a series of antique underground cellars used to store the wines of yesteryear. Ribera's bold, stylish red wines of today are perfect for sizzling steaks. Travelling northwest of Ribera del Duero or eastward of Aragón along the Ebro River brings you to Rioja, where historic monasteries and cathedrals create a backdrop to Spain's most famous wines. The region's complex, smoky reds and sunny rosés are outstanding with chorizo.



PRADOREY FINCA LA MINA RESERVA 2015

Single vineyard, DO Ribera del Duero

A TASTING TUTORIAL



Are you a newer wine lover with a thirst for knowledge? Check out our **simple guide to tasting** and you'll be sniffing, sipping and slurping like a pro in no time.

As with any skill, mastering wine tasting takes study, practice and repetition. But as the tools of the trade here are your own senses, it's possible to pick up the fundamentals in a surprisingly short time. This step-by-step guide – plus **a selection of wines specially chosen** to help illustrate some of wine's key characteristics – will show you the basics. Gather a few friends, get out your pens and make an evening of it. School is in session!



THE SET-UP

1/ Find a space as free of odours

(candles, cooking smells, perfumes or colognes) as possible. Try to avoid smoking or eating strong-flavoured foods prior to tasting. Chewing bread or drinking water can help cleanse the palate before the tasting and between wines.

2/ Cover your table with a white

cloth or sheet of paper against which to study the wine's colour. Natural daylight is best, or pure white lights (avoid soft-yellow bulbs).

3/ Chill your white and sparkling wines in advance. Have the reds at room temperature.

4/ For comparison tastings, have a separate glass for each wine, and set out spittoons or small cups. Spitting is an important part of tasting (ingesting the wine will impact your ability to taste, particularly if you're tasting several wines).

5/ Arrange your wines from light to full-bodied, with sweet wines at the end. Once you're experienced, tasting order can become a matter of personal preference.

6/ Have a notebook and pen for each participant, or use the notes app on your phones.

IT'S TIME TO **TASTE**!



POUR

About 60 mL (2 oz) of wine is plenty to allow you to assess it. Get your pen and paper ready and make notes as you go through each step.



LOOK

Hold the glass at about a 45° angle against your white background. Pay attention to the clarity of the wine and the intensity and hue of the colour.



Swirling oxygenates the wine, releasing and enhancing the aroma and flavour compounds. It also lets you observe the **tears:** the liquid that clings to the side of the glass. Wines with high levels of sugar or alcohol will have thicker and more persistent tears.



SNIFF

Enjoying a wine's aromas is one of the delights of tasting and provides important clues to a wine's nature. Take an initial gentle sniff to check for obvious faults such as cork taint, which smells like wet cardboard or a damp basement. Then get your nose right in there. Don't be shy! Draw in a deep, slow, steady sniff. Make note of what you're sensing and be as specific as you can. Primary aromas are the flower and fruit notes inherent to the grape. Secondary aromas are those produced by the winemaking process and can include buttery notes and/or nuts, biscuit, bread and oak. Tertiary aromas are introduced by the ageing process and can comprise caramel, toffee and vanilla.



SIP & SLURP

Take a small sip while drawing air in over your tongue to involve your nasal passage and enhance the flavours. Swish and swash like you're using mouthwash. Particular areas of your tongue may be more sensitive to certain flavours, and not everyone's tongue reacts the same way, so you want to make sure you engage it all. Pay attention to the **flavours** and also the **tannins**, **body**, **sweetness** and **acidity** (see page 26). Is the wine balanced? Does one characteristic overpower the others?



SPIT & CONTEMPLATE

Spit the wine and consider the finish (i.e., how long the sensations and flavours you identified last). A **short finish** is typical of lower-quality wines, while a **long finish** of a minute or more is an indication of a fine-quality wine.

COMPARE & CONTRAST

We paired up the 10 wines on these pages – based on their production method or a notable feature – so you can taste them side by side. Pay attention to how the tannins, body, acidity, intensity, sweetness and flavour profile differ for each wine, then compare notes afterwards. **Tannins** are compounds in red wines that create that drying sensation you also get from drinking black tea. They're more about texture and mouthfeel than flavour.

Body is the perception of "weight" in a wine. A light-bodied wine will feel a bit lighter and thinner in your mouth than a full-bodied one.

Just like fruit, wines have **acidity**, typically ranging from soft and light like a ripe pear to crisp and bright like a lemon.

Intensity is about how fast the aromas and flavours hit your sense of smell and taste buds. In general, if it's quick and strong, it's likely a more intense wine.

Sweetness is about how wine tastes (not necessarily the amount of sugar). An extra-dry wine won't taste sweet; a dessert wine will be at the other end of the spectrum.



TANK METHOD VS. TRADITIONAL-METHOD SPARKLERS

Prosecco is made using the tank method, in which the secondary fermentation takes place in a tank. This method produces lighter, more fruit-focused wines than the traditional method. Traditional-method sparklers are made in the same manner as Champagne, with the secondary fermentation taking place in the individual bottles. This imparts richness, creaminess and autolytic notes such as toast and brioche. The bubbles are also smaller and more persistent than those in sparkling wines produced by other methods. All sparkling wines have bright, fresh acidity.

INTENSE VS. SUBTLE AROMATICS

Sauvignon Blancs from cool regions such as Marlborough will have intensely herbaceous and tropical aromatics. Chardonnay is rarely aromatically pronounced, instead reflecting more vineyard characteristics such as minerality. It also shows the influence of winemaking techniques such as lees ageing and time in oak, the latter of which adds suggestions of caramel and vanilla.

LIGHTER VS. Fuller Body

Body is the textural impact of alcohol, sugars, fruit extract and acidity. Lighter-bodied wines such as Gamay will typically be low in alcohol, high in acidity and daintily flavoured, while fuller-bodied wines like Cabernet will have higher alcohol, more intense flavours and often grippy tannins.

LESS VS. More tannic

Tannins are extracted from grape skins, seeds and stems, as well as from oak. They're rarely a consideration for white wines, but they're an important element in assessing all reds. Tannins create a drying sensation on your gums and contribute to a wine's texture, and they range from astringent to velvety. Taste this Pinot Noir and Barolo side by side and compare and contrast the impact of the tannins.

AGEING IN OAK VS. NO OAK

Fermenting a white wine in oak barrels introduces flavours such as smoke, vanilla and clove, as well as creating a creamy texture and adding depth, complexity and weight to the wine. Chablis typically sees no oak at any stage. This emphasizes the purity of fruit, razor-sharp acidity and minerality of the wine. Texture and body can be enhanced through lees ageing.

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DID **You** Know?

A skilled taster can identify many things about a wine, including the type of grape, the vintage, where and how it was made, and even what its price point might be. For anyone new to tasting, this can seem akin to a magic trick, but really it's more like assembling a puzzle; playing a game of 20 questions with your own senses. Don't be discouraged if you mistake a Merlot for a Cabernet. As they say, practice makes **perfect**, and there are few things as enjoyable to practice as tasting wine.






