# POSTS





Wine reviews and their accompanying scores are top tools for understanding the nuances of wine and finding something you love. Here, a primer on how scores can help you, paired with 14 fine wines that make the grade.

A 90+ score from a trusted source can give you the confidence to select a wine you've never tried and explore a new region, varietal or price point at a glance. But like they say, knowledge is power. We encourage you to become familiar with different scoring systems, what scores mean, and the critics behind them so that you can more accurately assess their value to you specifically. This collection of top-scoring wines is a good place to start.



# TASTE TEST

Though expert opinions can help inform our choices, it's important to remember that tasting wine is a very personal experience.

We all, critics included, have our preferences. If you don't like sweet wines, a 99-point *Wine Spectator* score for a Sauternes will not make that wine taste any better to you. One of the most stimulating aspects of wine is the great diversity and range of styles and flavours available. Finding critics whose palates and recommendations, more often than not, align with your own inclinations can take some trial and error but can help guide your purchasing decisions, allowing you to zero in on exactly the wine you like or providing the confidence to take the plunge and try something new.

# EXPLORERS' CLUB

Reading and understanding a variety of critics is a great way to empower yourself when you want to discover new wines and regions.

Understanding what a 90+ from Lisa Perrotti-Brown of [robertparker.com](http://robertparker.com) or Roger Voss of *Wine Enthusiast* means, or being able to recognize the value in a score of 88 or 89, can help you venture out of your comfort zone and take a chance on a wine or producer you're completely unfamiliar with. Even if the wine proves to be not entirely to your taste, a review and/or score can give you assurance that it was an excellent example of that particular style, helping you identify and fine-tune your own palate. Scores can open up whole new regions and experiences to you, helping expand your personal reference points for all wines.



# EXPERT INSIGHT

Professional wine tasters assess wine within a particular style's own context, regardless of personal preferences.

This is why it's also important to read their notes whenever you can – it might help you understand why a wine you don't like received 93 points from a critic you do. It will also help you learn about benchmark characteristics of a particular grape or style. When possible, reading and comparing a variety of reviews for the same wine will help you calibrate your palate and your understanding of the scores. The credibility of your source is also important. Names such as Robert Parker, *Wine Spectator*, Jancis Robinson and *Wine Enthusiast* carry significant international weight, while sites such as [winealign.com](http://winealign.com) and [winecurrent.com](http://winecurrent.com) are just two of the excellent local resources you can draw on for dependable recommendations. Competitions, such as the Decanter World Wine Awards or the National Wine Awards of Canada, confer scores or medals that are based on the expert opinions of a panel of judges.

# KNOW THE SCORE

It pays to be familiar with the concept and context of various rating systems, from the 100- and 20-point scales to stars and wineglasses. Of course, the numbers don't tell the whole story – it's important to find critics whose palates align with your own, and read the full tasting notes to get a deeper sense of the wine. Here's a quick roundup of some rating systems frequently seen in our Vintages releases.

## THE 100-POINT SYSTEM

Popularized by Robert Parker Jr. in the early 1980s and now used by most mainstream critics, the 100-point scoring system revolutionized the wine world. In Parker's system, every wine is automatically given 50 points; further points are awarded for colour and appearance (up to 5), aroma (up to 15), flavour and finish (up to 20) and overall quality (up to 10). The 100-point system is embraced by publications such as *Wine Spectator*, *Wine Enthusiast* and *Decanter* as well as many Canadian critics.

## THE 5-STAR SCALE

This popular system borrows from the familiar hotel-rating system. New Zealand wine critic Michael Cooper favours this approach, as do some wine competitions.

- ★★★★☆ = Excellent quality, verging on outstanding

## THE 3-STAR/GLASS SCALES

French and Italian wine guides *Le Guide Hachette* and *Gambero Rosso Italian Wines* both use scales out of 3. Similar to the *Michelin Guide* for restaurants, it's an honour even to be mentioned in these guides.

### Le Guide Hachette

- ★★★ = Exceptional wine
- ★★☆ = Remarkable wine
- ★☆☆ = Very well-made wine
- Mention = Well-made wine

### Gambero Rosso Italian Wines

- ☞☞☞ = Excellent wine in its category
- ☞☞☞ = Very good to excellent in its category
- ☞☞☞ = Good wine in its category

## THE 20-POINT SCALE

A more traditional wine scale favoured notably by Jancis Robinson. Any wine she scores above 15 points is considered highly recommended.

- 20 = Truly exceptional
- 19 = A humdinger
- 18 = A cut above superior
- 17 = Superior
- 16 = Distinguished
- 15 = A perfectly nice drink

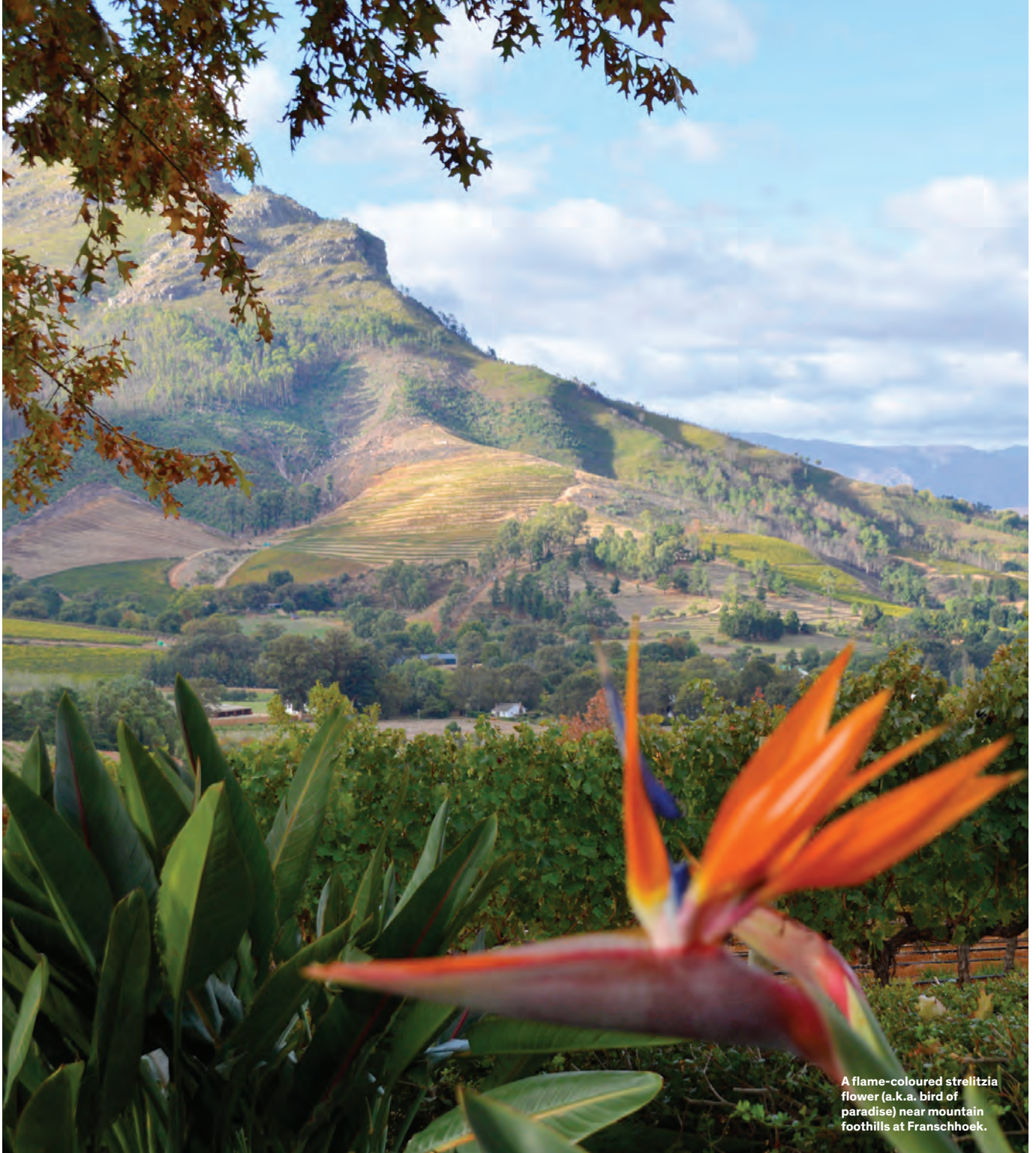

South Africa has a long viticultural heritage and can date its first plantings to 1655, with the first wines being produced in 1659. Although it's best known for its signature Pinotage and Chenin Blanc, South Africa is home to a vast range of characterful, premium-quality wines that encompass many of the world's most popular varieties and styles. Winemakers continue to explore and refine their understanding of their unique terroir which, coupled with a widespread commitment to sustainability, has propelled South African wines to the fore of the world stage.

## *A range of* **RED WINES**

South Africa's signature red grape, **Pinotage**, is a cross between Pinot Noir and Cinsault. A South African specialty, it can produce lithe Beaujolais-like wines with bright red berry tones or, when sourced from old bush vines, rich, full, spicy wines. **Syrah** exhibits elegant, rich dark fruit and spicy pepper notes here, with warmer sites reflecting a more overt fruity character. An individual winery's choice of the type of oak, and how they use it, greatly influences the style. **Grenache** is ideally suited to warm, dry conditions, and in South Africa it produces wines with ripe berry and spice aromas and flavours. In South Africa, **Cabernet Sauvignon** is used in blends and as a varietal wine. SA Cabs offer a winning combination of ripe New World fruit and Old World refinement.





**THE WINERY OF GOOD HOPE

**TASTING NOTE:** This has an impressive, fresh red and black berry character to its aromas, framed by a light touch of smoke. ## *Winning* **WHITE WINES**

First brought to the country in the 1920s and planted in an experimental vineyard at the University of Stellenbosch, **Chardonnay** didn't become a part of South Africa's fine-wine scene until the mid-1980s. It does exceptionally well in cooler coastal sites, and styles run the gamut from light and steely through to rich and buttery. Burgundian-style barrel fermentation and lees stirring create wines with a notably premium character. South Africa is also renowned for its **Chenin Blanc**, along with other favourites like **Sauvignon Blanc**. Chenin from cooler sites like Elgin tend to be unoaked and have delicate fruit tones; warmer areas like Stellenbosch produce Chenin with more intense tropical fruit, with some seeing oak. While this release features only Chardonnay, we regularly offer a range of South African white wines in Vintages. Look for them in upcoming releases.

OUTSIDE SOUTH AFRICA

In 1998, South Africa introduced the Integrated Production of Wine (IPW) sustainability initiative and today, over 95% of the country's growers and wineries have adopted sustainable measures aimed at supporting conservation and protecting and encouraging biodiversity.

In 2010, the South African Wine and Spirit Board created a seal that qualifying wines can carry. This seal certifies the authenticity of the wine's vintage, variety and region and verifies that the wine was produced in accordance with sustainable practices. You can enter the numbers of the seal on your wine at [sawis.co.za/sealsearch.php](http://sawis.co.za/sealsearch.php) to trace the wine's origins all the way from the bottle to the vine.



The list of socioeconomic initiatives in South Africa is also impressive and far-reaching and includes, among others, Wine & Agricultural Industry Ethical Trade Association (WIETA), established in 2002; Wine Training South Africa (WTSA), founded in 2005; and the Pebbles Project, begun in 2004, which focuses on providing education to children and families in the agricultural communities of the Western Cape.

# WINING AND DINING

**Feast your senses at – or plan a future visit to – these four Niagara wineries with acclaimed restos showcasing fine local ingredients. Vineyard views included.**

As we adjust to the new realities of physical distancing and rules and restrictions continue to evolve, those special parts of our former routines that we can maintain will become even more treasured. Among them, visiting wine country. Niagara offers stunning scenery, the ethereal aromas and flavours of amazing wines, and of course, great farm-to-table foods. We spoke to some of the people behind four of Niagara's must-visit-must-dine wineries.









## Vineland

When you sit down to a meal at Vineland, you find yourself right in the heart of Niagara's fine-wine history. "The restaurant sits within the St. Urban Vineyard, planted in 1979 with vines transplanted to Ontario from the Mosel in Germany by Hermann Weis," explains Vineland president Allan Schmidt. "We call our Italian- and Mediterranean-influenced menu 'wine country casual.'
